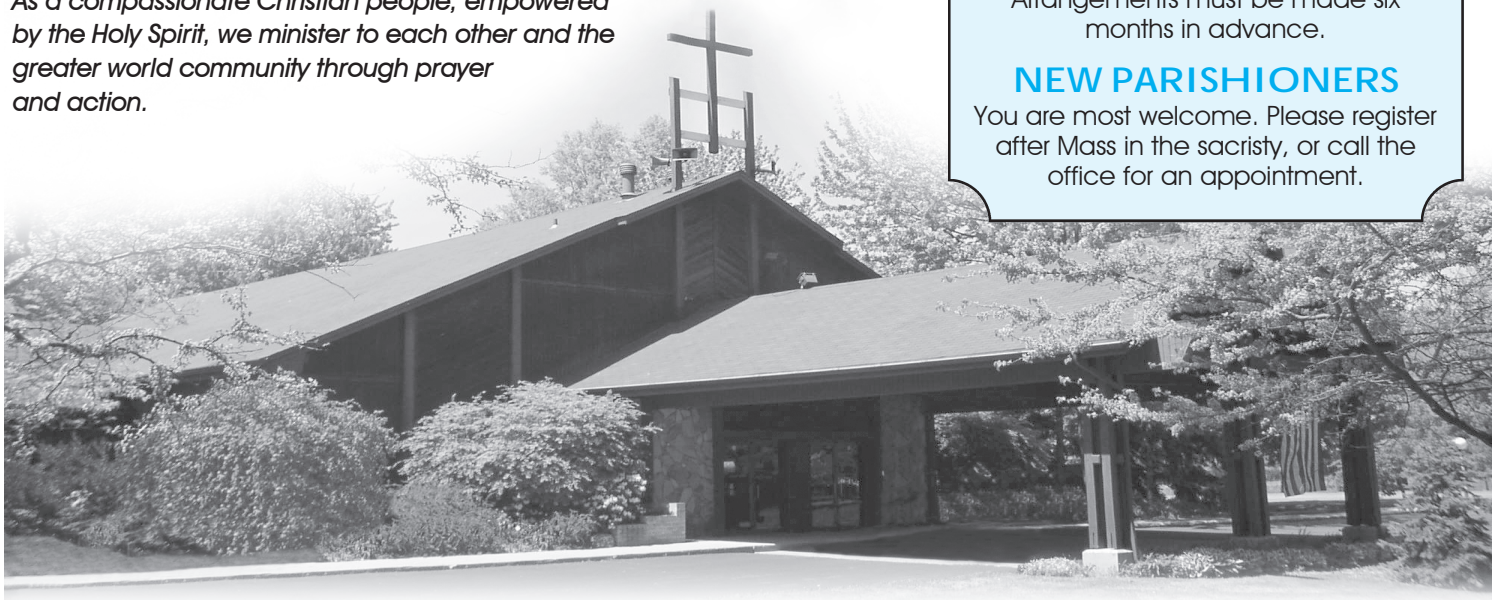

## From the Desk of Father Gonser

On the first Friday of each month there is public adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Special prayers are offered at 8:30 a.m. in the Chapel for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life. After the 8:30 a.m. Mass is celebrated, the rosary is prayed before the Blessed Sacrament. Parishioners are encouraged to spend half an hour in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. This could be a good prayer practice for Lent and could be continued throughout the year.
