On the fourth Sunday of Lent we gather, at the 9:00 a.m. Mass, to support the three candidates of the R.C.I.A. at the Second Scrutiny or blessing as they reaffirm their commitment to join our parish community at the solemn Easter Vigil Service. I ask all parishioners to pray for them and to consider participating at the Holy 8:30 p.m. service.

In just two short weeks we will celebrate Holy Week. The week of prayer is filled with very dramatic celebrations of Our Lord's final days on earth. It begins with the blessing and distribution of palm branches on Palm Sunday. It continues with the solemn celebration of the Mass on Holy Thursday, Good Friday's Stations of the Cross and the reading of the Passion and, finally, the celebration of Resurrected Life on Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday. Our Mission on March 22 and 23 will be an excellent introduction to the Holy Week services. Plan to come with your family and friends and enjoy a very unique celebration of family and faith.

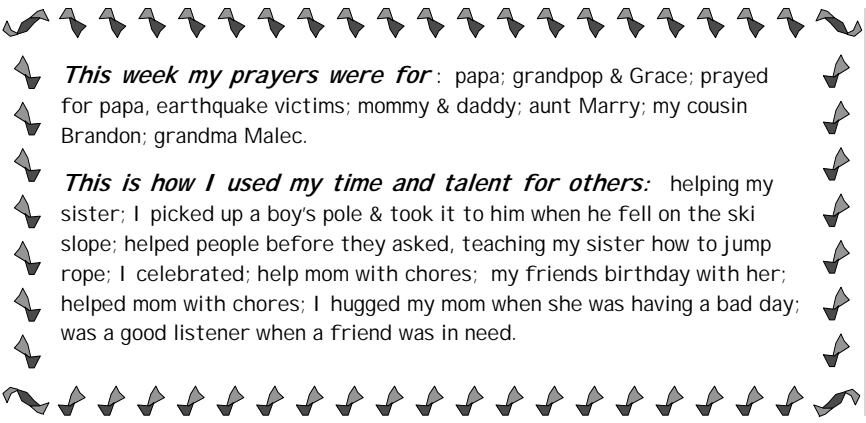
Two Opportunities are available this week to join a Prayer Vigil at area abortion clinics:
