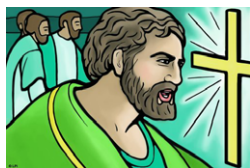

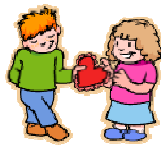
### IHN—Week of July 4-11

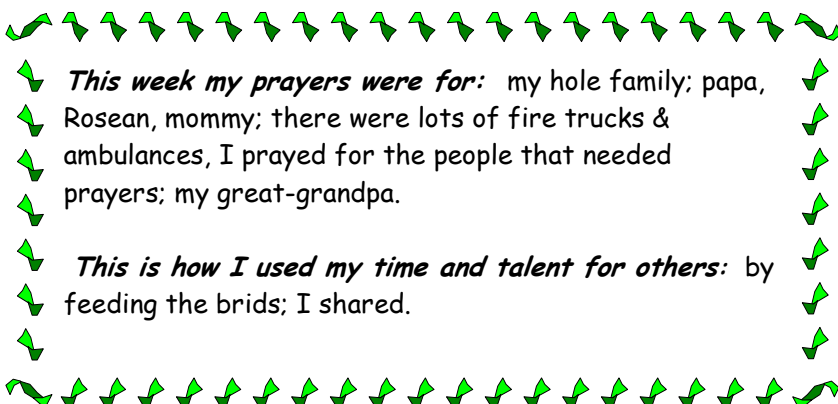
