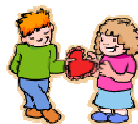

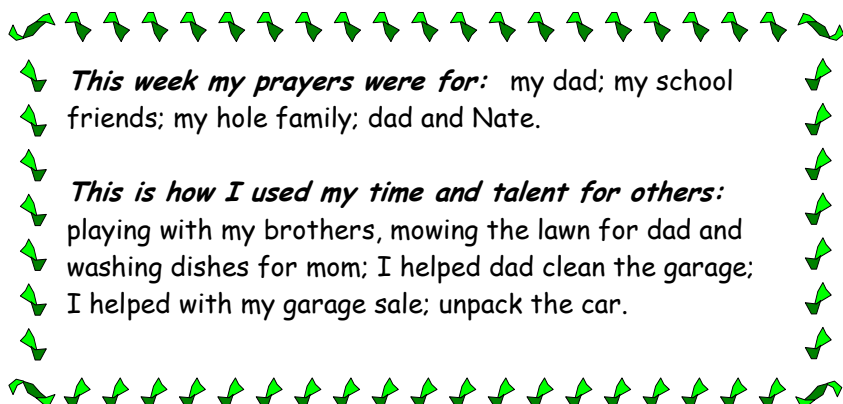
Baptism Classes for the Summer
