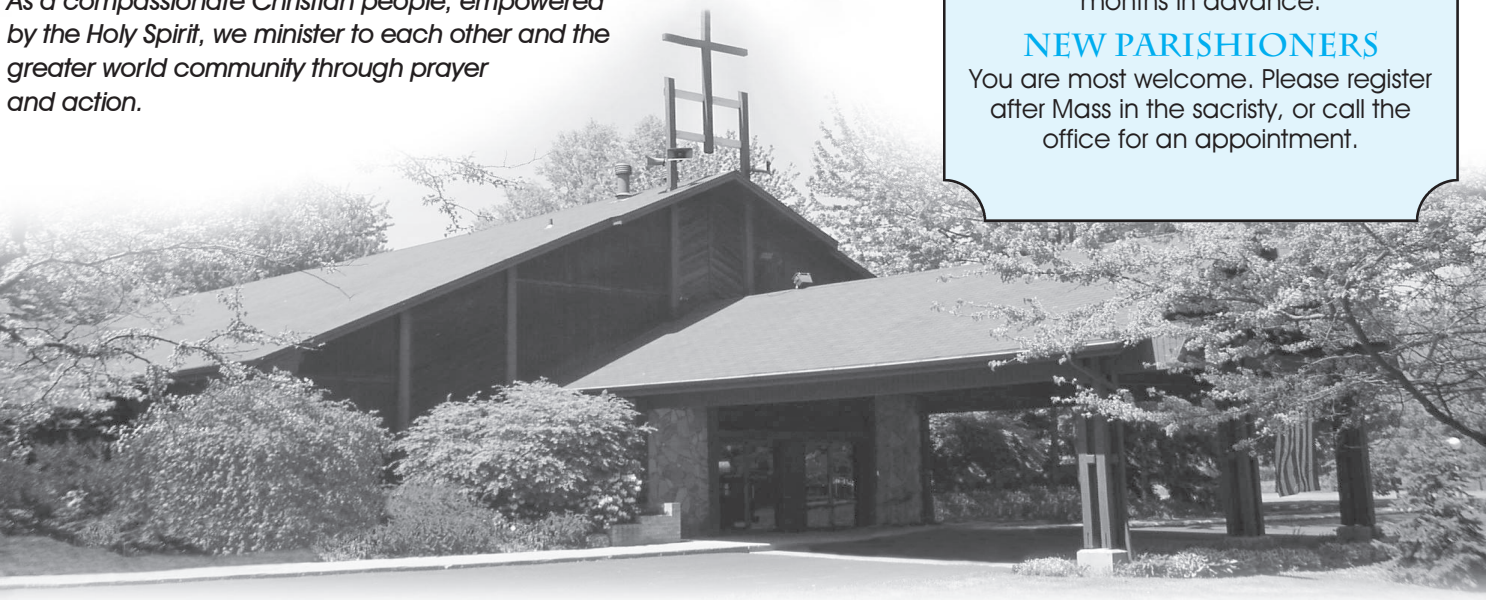

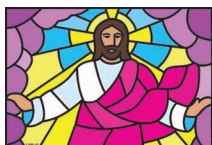

### Special Instruments are Used in Benediction



The monstrance is a portable receptacle used for the exposition of the blessed Sacrament and its use dates back to the 13th century. The Blessed Sacrament is placed in a lunette to hold it in an upright position so it can be placed in the monstrance and clearly seen. Monstrances are typically made of gold or silver with crystal or glass employed to allow the contents to be easily distinguished. Many lunettes are surrounded, like the sun with rays focusing the eye to the Blessed Sacrament. Monstrances have also been used to exhibit relics of a saint.
