I encourage you to pray daily for the end to abortion and for respect for life in all of its stages. I will celebrate a special Mass for Life on Wednesday, October 5th in the Chapel at 7:00 p.m. followed by a Holy Hour. Without prayer our efforts cannot succeed. With prayer we can do all things in Christ. In the month of October the rosary will be prayed daily at the Chapel following the 8:30 a.m. Mass. Also, the rosary is prayed every Wednesday evening at 7:30 in the Church. This practice was started over 20 years ago to pray for our armed forces and for world peace.

Last Sunday was a great start to our PSR program, lots of new faces this year. We have been increasing our membership, as of this week we welcomed our 711th family. I anticipate our membership to increase to 725 by Christmas thanks to everyone's effort to evangelize neighbors and friends to attend mass and consider active membership at our parish.

Since the Spring 40 Days for Life campaign ended, two more abortion centers where 40 Days for Life vigils have been conducted have shut their doors and CLOSED! Please pray and fast every day as you are able that the miracles will continue and that abortion will end. Prayer cards are available at the back of church. To help maintain focus on the Lord and stay in tune with His guidance, a series of daily devotionals are available to guide you through each day of the 40 Days for Life at www.40daysforlife.com.

The 40 Days for Life Prayer Vigil is ongoing for all 40 days at three abortion mills in the Cleveland area. St. Julie Parishioners will be out praying at the Cleveland Surgi Center abortion mill at 4269 Pearl Rd. once a week on Saturday mornings. Our next vigil time is Saturday, October 8th from 11am to 12noon. A group from St. Peter will be out praying each Tuesday afternoon from 3-4pm.
