From the desk of Fr. Bob...

Dear Parishioners,

Last weekend's Confirmation at the 5:00 p.m. Mass was a great blessing for the seven young people who were confirmed and for St. Julie Parish. It was their personal Pentecost. As we celebrate Pentecost this weekend with the Church Universal, let us pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

This Solemnity is a special day for each of us. Pentecost was the event that moved the disciples out of the Upper Room and into the streets. St. Peter and the other Eleven apostles proclaimed Jesus Christ and baptized 3000 repentant believers. In truth, it is the Birthday of the Church. However, more than an important historical event, Pentecost is to be the perpetual reality of the Church. It is only by the power of the Holy Spirit that we will be able to remain faithful to Jesus Christ and fulfill our mission of evangelizing the world. Let us pray:

COME HOLY SPIRIT-TODAY AND EVERYDAY UNTIL THE LORD RETURNS!

Monday, May 29, is also a special day locally and universally. Locally, it is Memorial Day. We especially remember those men and women who sacrificed in the service of our country so that we can enjoy the rights and freedoms we have as citizens of the United States. Though some people have taken to bashing the United States, highlighting its faults and failures, I am grateful to be a citizen of this country. No country is perfect. However, this is a land of opportunity, justice, and freedom. I pray that each of us express our gratitude by using our freedom to serve others and proclaim Christ. Mass on Memorial Day will be at 9:00 a.m. and all are welcome.

And Monday, being the day after Pentecost, is now the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church. May her prayers and example help us to live as the faithful Bride of Christ.

St. Julie Parish has upgraded its ability to livestream Mass. For the last few weeks we had irresolvable problems. This week we switched streaming services. We are hopeful that this will smooth out the streaming experience for those who view the livestream. Our upgrade will also allow us to stream other events on and off campus. Blessed Carlo Acutis, pray for us!

The weekend of June 10 & 11, is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. This feast day highlights the reality that the Eucharist is the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. In honor of our Lord's, St. Peter and St. Julie Parishes will be processing with the Blessed Sacrament from St. Peter Parish to St. Julie Parish (a little over two miles) at the conclusion of the Noon Mass. Our route will be down Center Ridge Rd. to Emerald St. (by Giant Eagle). We will cross Center Ridge Rd. and continue down the side streets and enter the property of St. Julie's through their private road, Julie Lane. After a brief period of adoration and prayer, we will have Benediction and a social. **And fret not: rides back to St. Peter Parish to pick up your cars will be provided.** (continued)

Respect Life

Life in its earliest and most vulnerable stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to the Ohio Constitution for the November 2023 ballot to expand and enshrine abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women. The Catechism of the Catholic Church proclaims that "human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception." The Church accompanies and supports women facing unexpected pregnancies and mothers through programs like Walking with Moms in Need and the services of Catholic Charities. The bishops of Ohio strongly encourage Catholics statewide to unite in prayer and work to defeat this proposed amendment and its grave consequences for women and preborn children in Ohio. 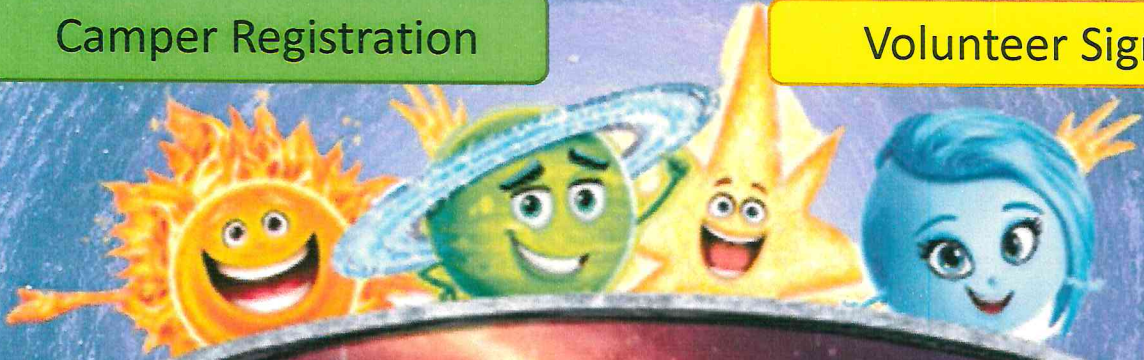
