

Dear Parishioners.

Today's Feast, The Body and Blood of Christ, kicks of a year for parishes in the United States to intentionally focus on the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. These years of Eucharistic Revival (ending in 2025) are meant to deepen our understanding and devotion to the Eucharist. Upcoming events for our parish in the year 2023-2024 will include book studies on the Eucharist. I would also like to send some representatives to the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana in June of 2024. Finally, we will be training and sending out parishioners to visit homes and deliver sort of a "welcome packet" from Jesus, giving them information about our parish and the Eucharist.

We kick off this year with the Eucharistic Procession from St. Peter Parish to St. Julie Parish. All are welcome and details are on the flyer in this bulletin. If you are not able to walk that far, please simply drive to St. Julie Parish by 1:45 p.m. or so. When the procession arrives, you will be able to participate in the prayer service, Benediction and social. For those who do walk, there will be a bus from St. Julie's to St. Peter's leaving around 3:00 p.m. so that you can pick up your car.

#### Looking Back:

- 1. Pastor Tom Joyce, who has been the pastor of Fields United Methodist for the last 13 years is retiring. He has faithfully served his church and the City of North Ridgeville. Over the years he has strongly encouraged our annual ecumenical Thanksgiving Service and the Good Friday Cross Walk. Pastor Tom has also served on the board of Community Care for many years. May the Lord bless him as he enters into this new chapter of his life.
- 2. This past week included a number of interesting meetings, highlighted by my first time participating in the St. Julie Budget meeting. It is actually a good way to become a bit more deeply acquainted with the workings of the parish. By the grace of God and generosity of you, the people of St. Julie Parish, we will end the year in the black and plan on doing so in the year 2023-2024.
- 3. Last Sunday was our first Cycling Saints outing of the year. With five parishioners from St. Julie's and eight from St. Peter's we were a force to be reckoned with on the multi-propose path. Actually, everyone was quite polite: we who road and those we passed. We only lost one cyclist. Jim Foster had a flat about one mile into the fifteen-mile ride. He made it back safely.

Finally, the words of Jesus in today's gospel make up some of his most inspiring and yet challenging teaching. He told the Jews and his disciples, "Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you do not have life in you...for my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink..." The response of many of his disciples was to return to their former way of life (see John 6:61, 66). We have

the advantage of hearing these words in the light of the actions of Jesus at the Last Supper, when He gave us the Sacrament of His Body and Blood. May we ever treasure the gift of the Eucharist and more closely follow Him.

The Proxession & Adoration

Beginning at St. Peter Catholic Church the Route will proceed going East on Center Ridge to Emerald, to Pearl, to Opal, to Julie Lane.

Two stops for brief prayer will be made along the route. Water will be available.

Silent Time for Prayer and Adoration, Daytime Prayer, and Benediction will take place at St. Julie Billiart at the end of the Eucharistic Procession.

The Eucharistic Procession will begin at St. Peter Catholic Church at 1:00pm. It is recommended participants park at St. Peter Church.

Following the Eucharistic Procession a shuttle will be available beginning at 3:00pm. The shuttle will make multiple trips from St. Julie to St. Peter in order to return participants to their cars.
