

From the desk of Fr. George...

Greetings Parishioners and friends of St. Julie's,

Like it or not, in a few short days it will be Lent.

Many dread Lent. They say it is too hard, too long and too much work. But I suppose it is all in how one looks at it.

It is time to change that attitude!

Lent is like a fine wine that is to be savored. It is a season of prayer, reflection, repentance, and sacrifice that needs to be drunk with passion and sipped with delight at the discovery of what God has done.

Prayer should not be seen as a duty or drudgery. Rather, prayer is a privilege that enables us to talk with God Almighty... and as one television cook often says: "How good is that!"

Just a reminder: Our observance of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, 2 March 2022, a day of fast and abstinence for Catholics. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of universal fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their

60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal.

Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.
