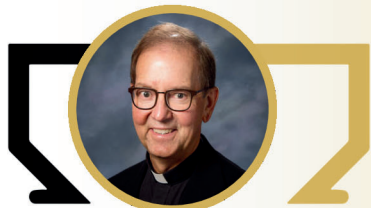

Dear Parishioners,

God is good to our fathers and to all of us. This Sunday is special day for our fathers. Happy Father's Day. As we celebrate Father's Day, we give thanks for the husbands and fathers we love. Their sacrifices, guidance, example, and unwavering love for their families and communities are gifts that deserve our gratitude and appreciation.

The readings remind us of God's faithful care and protection. In the First Reading, Jeremiah faces opposition and fear, yet he places his trust in the Lord, confident that God stands beside him as a mighty champion. 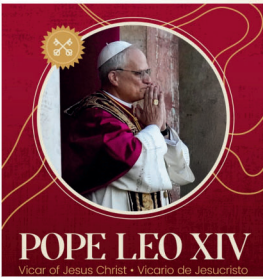

June is Safety Month at St. Julie's

Keeping You and Your Family Safe in an Emergency

Emergency Preparedness

- ✓ **Prioritize immediate evacuation routes** and hazard awareness and establish two ways out of every room
- ✓ **Establish a clear safety exit route** and practice regular drills with your family.
- ✓ **Maintain a grab-and-go kit** with a 3-day supply of water and medication
- ✓ **Prepare basic survival kits** for adults, children, and pets. Include a multi-purpose tool, first aid kit, extra batteries, and copies of personal documents.
- ✓ **Clearly label your circuit breaker box** and know how to safely turn off your water and gas valves if you suspect a leak or structural damage.

Preventative Home Upkeep

- ✓ **Set your water heater temperature** no higher than 120°F (49°C) to prevent accidental scalding.
- ✓ **Keep fire extinguishers handy** in the kitchen and garage, and make sure all family members know how to operate them.
- ✓ **Install smoke and carbon monoxide detectors on every floor.** Test them monthly and replace batteries every six months.
- ✓ **Keep flammables away** from space heaters and other heat sources.
- ✓ **Rely on flashlights during a blackout.** Unattended candles pose a severe fire risk.
- ✓ **Never use your oven or stovetop** to heat your home.
