#### 2nd Sunday of Lent

Dear Parishioners.

St. Patrick's Day is Monday. His life teaches us that one person can make a big difference. In his early years, Patrick was lax in his faith. However, being kidnapped from England and made a slave/shepherd in Ireland, Patrick experienced hardship and loneliness. He learned to pray. Inspired to run away, Patrick escaped to France, where he became a priest. When his monastery's first bishop/missionary to Ireland unexpectedly died, Patrick was sent back to Ireland to convert his former captors. The rest, as they say, is history. St. Patrick succeeded in vanquishing evil religious practices and establishing a Christian culture Ireland, which became a springboard for missionary work in other parts of the world.

Though we celebrate St. Patrick's Day with parades and corned beef, this saint's ultimate legacy was the gospel. May this always be first in our minds. I do not believe that St. Patrick would be opposed to fun, so here's a joke and some Irish wisdom.

Why can't you borrow money from leprechauns? Because they are always a little short. How is a good friend like a 4-leaf clover? Because they are hard to find and lucky to have.

On Wednesday, we celebrate St. Joseph. Though we have no recorded words of St. Joseph, his example and influence speak volumes. He is a powerful intercessor. St. Thomas Aquinas says of him, "There are many saints to whom God has given the power to assist us in the necessities of life, but the power given to St Joseph is unlimited: it extends to all our needs, and all those who invoke him with confidence are sure to be heard." One of our modern saints, St. Josemaria Escriva, says, "Joseph can tell us many things about Jesus. Therefore, never neglect devotion to him - Ite ad Ioseph: "Go to Joseph" - as Christian tradition puts it in the words of the Old Testament (Gen. 41:55)."

May our honor of St. Patrick and St. Joseph assist in our needs and help us grow in virtue!

This is the week for Confessions! With all the parishes in the Diocese of Cleveland, St. Julie/St. Parish will begin hearing confessions after the 5:30 p.m. Mass on Wednesday (around 6:15 p.m.) and end around 8:00 p.m. St. Peter Parish will be offering the confession from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. If you happen to go to another parish for whatever reason, Fr. Isidore and I will not be offended. The important thing is for us to go!

## Our Ukrainian Welcome Circle and the Bryiovskyis continue to ask for your prayers!

We are continuing to monitor the Immigration actions being taken by the administration through the ongoing Zoom meetings with legal representatives of the United States Council of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and Welcome US. The Humanitarian Parole Program remains under fire with uncertain consequences for all paroles here under the program, including the Bryiovskyis.

The constant anxiety the Bryiovskyis feel about their current fragile (but legal) US immigration status adds to their everyday fears about their family members left in Ukraine. They need our help. So, we ask that you continue to pray for them and their families.

If you contacted your representatives, we thank you. We encourage you to remain engaged by making your voice heard.






