## PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners,

Beginning this weekend, the "For the People" Mass at each parish will be renamed. Instead of For the People of St. Peter Parish or For the People of St. Julie Parish, those Masses will be renamed *For the People of St. Julie and St. Peter Parishes*. I will be the celebrant of one of those Masses. Eventually, there will be one Mass for both parishes, which will alternate between St. Julie and St. Peter Parishes. Know that you, the people of God in both parishes, are in my daily prayers as well as at a Sunday Mass.

I am grateful for the labors of Niki Sherman (and her spouse Deacon Del) and her team of volunteers. For five evenings, Sunday through Thursday, a group of 60 or so youth, teens and adults gathered to experience the Changemakers Vacation Bible School. The 45 children were making crafts, dancing, singing and even snacking their way through the Changemaker VBS material. I pray that the Word of God they welcomed during VBS bear good fruit in their lives for years to come.

I continue to encourage people to sign up for the August 2nd Auto-Rama Mass, picnic and movie event. Everyone is welcome, even those who do not normally come to Mass. The event is free. However, because the drive-in can only hold so many cars, we need to sign up. Carpooling is encouraged. I will be the main celebrant at the Mass and the homilist will be Fr. Anthony Donatelli from Holy Trinity/St. Mary's in Avon.

Less than two weeks later, Lorain County will be hosting one of the premiere events of our Diocese: The Fest! For the last 25 years this event has been held at the Center for Pastoral Leadership in Wickliffe. This year, the Fest will be held at Crusher Stadium in Avon on Saturday, August 15. Due to this new format, there is an entrance fee charge of \$10.00/person. Tickets can be purchased online at [www.thefest.us](http://www.thefest.us). Also, St. Peter and St. Julie Parishes have a limited number of tickets at their offices. Contact the office if you want one or more of those tickets.

The gospel this weekend highlights the power of the gospel and the peril of life on earth. Jesus described the message of the Kingdom like a mustard seed and leaven. These substances are small and almost invisible. Yet, when they take root or are mixed into one's life, they are transformative. However, as transformative as the message of the Kingdom is, there is an enemy sowing seeds that bend one's life away from God. These seeds are deformative. These "weeds" make one's life useless for God.

These words of Jesus are sobering. They highlight the ultimate destinies of our souls: heaven or hell. We need to remember these two things. First, the words of Jesus should never lead us to despair. We should never judge ourselves or others as weeds fit for the fire. Christ is the judge of the living and the dead. Secondly, these parables use inanimate things to unveil spiritual truths. We are not inanimate. We have the power to choose. An honest confession can move us from a weed to wheat.

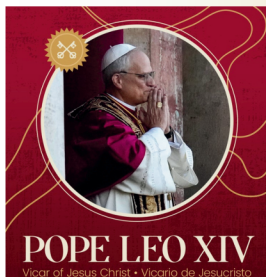
