Last Weekend, Bishop Malesic initiated a 3-year program of Eucharistic Revival in the Diocese of Cleveland. Please see additional information in today's bulletin about the timeline for this truly relevant and central teaching of our faith.

ATTENTION, ATTENTION, ATTENTION! This is the time to consider inviting your family and friends to consider full membership in the Catholic Faith. The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) will once again convene in late summer or early fall. This is an opportunity for those who have never been: baptized, those baptized outside the Catholic Church, or those baptized Catholic who have never received the sacrament of Holy Eucharist; to be baptized, profess their belief in the Catholic faith or to complete the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are an adult who has never been Confirmed, there is a separate process to complete your initiation. Either way, call Fr. George at the parish office: 243-3877.

Over the next three years, every Catholic diocese, parish, school, apostolate, and family is

- Year of Diocesan Revival, June 19, 2022 — July 11, 2023
 - ◇ This first year of the Revival invites diocesan staff, bishops, and priests to respond to the Lord's personal invitation and equips them to share this love with the faithful through Eucharistic congresses and events.
- Year of Parish Revival, June 11, 2023 — July 17, 2024
 - ◇ The second phase will foster Eucharistic devotion at the parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, Missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit.
- National Eucharistic Congress and Year of Mission July 17—21, 2024
 - ◇ At this historic event, more than 80,000 Catholics of all ages will gather in Indianapolis to reconsecrate their hearts to the source and summit of our faith.

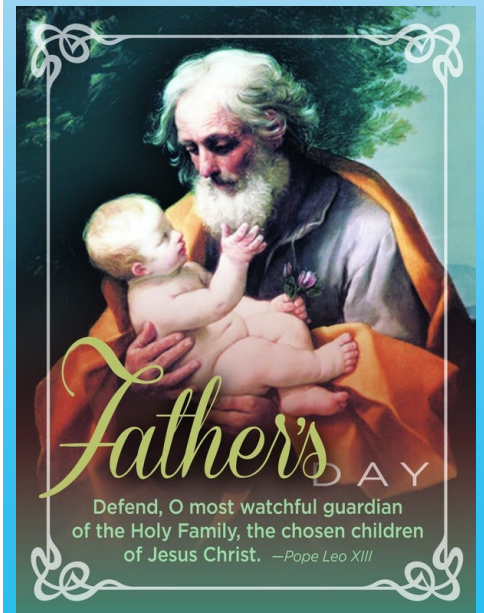

REFLECT

“...Fatherhood is first a spiritual reality, because fatherhood has its origins in God who chose to reveal Himself to us as Our Father, sending his only Son for the sake of our salvation. Fathers therefore have a special and unique role ‘in revealing and in reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God’ (FC 25). Fathers have a vital, unique, and important role to play in the personal and spiritual development of their children, and in reflecting the love of God the Father himself. Fathers are called to show the world the virtues of a tender protector, while living out the virtues of humility and courage.

In all circumstances, but especially in difficult circumstances, a father needs to be encouraged to faithfully accept the role entrusted to him by God and support the mother of his child. Through our prayers and through the intercession of St. Joseph, patron of fathers, may fathers come to know the *irreplaceable* role they hold in the lives of their children, and the responsibility they share in welcoming God’s gift of new life!...”

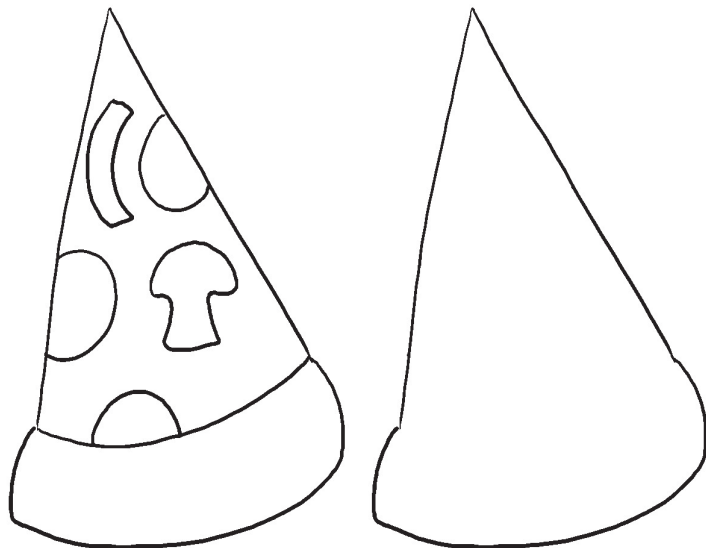
