


PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

I am grateful for our young adults who are responding to the Lord's call and seeking marriage in the Church. And I am also continuing to bless couples who were married outside the church and are seeking the sacrament of marriage. Fundamental to the passing on of the faith are Catholic families. Let us pray that the vocation to marriage be renewed in our time. May the Lord inspire our young people to embrace marriage as a vocation by which they follow Christ and raise their children in the Church.

This is Gaudete Sunday, "Gaudete" meaning rejoice. The reason for our rejoicing is that Advent is more than half over. In ten days, we will be celebrating Christmas, the birth of our Savior. Our Mass readings contain the words joy, rejoice, or rejoicing around eight times. And why? St. Paul simply states: "The Lord is near." As we journey through these last days of Advent, amid the busyness of preparing for Christmas, may we not forget to rejoice. We are Christians. The source of joy is already in our midst. Christ is among us.


