

Dear Parishioners,

Last Wednesday we began the season of Lent. This liturgical season originally began as a special time for those preparing to encounter Christ in the Easter sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and the Eucharist. Lent was a time for them to prepare for a new birth and live a new life in Christ.

The Church noted that Lent was so fruitful for those preparing for the Easter sacraments, the Church decided to enjoy this season on all the faithful. By our Lenten practices, we seek to embrace our new life in Christ. As we welcome the graces of this season, I pray that you and I are internally transformed and reflect the person of Christ in a fuller manner.

I do not recall a Lent in my 42 years as a priest that has as many opportunities for encountering the Lord as St. Peter and St. Julie Parishes has this Lent. Besides the normal things that make up the rhythm of Lent (daily Mass, Stations of the Cross, and extra opportunities for the Sacrament of Penance), there are numerous retreat opportunities, bible studies, and other programs. From the prayerful witnessing of 40 Days for Life to a parish mission with a former Hollywood soap opera star to a Eucharistic Revival retreat day-there are multiple opportunities to feed the soul and serve the mission of Christ. The gospel reading for the First Sunday of

Lent focuses on the temptations of Jesus in desert.

This period of temptation covers the three main enemies of humanity: the world, the flesh, and the devil. In Luke's gospel, the first temptation deals with the flesh. Jesus thwarted the temptation by quoting, Man does not live on bread alone but by every word that comes from the mouth of God. (Dt. 8:3) The second temptation focuses on the devil. By bending the knee to the devil and spurning the cross would be the ultimate shortcut. However, it would put the world in Satan's grip! Jesus answered, you shall worship the Lord, your God and him alone shall you serve. (Dt. 6:13) The third temptation focuses on the world. To throw oneself off the temple and be caught by angels for a soft landing would be spectacular. Wouldn't that make a great Facebook post? And doesn't scripture support this? He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you...With their hands they will support you, lest you dash your foot against a stone. (Psalm 91) Jesus knew

Our Ukrainian Welcome Circle and the Bryiovskyis continue to ask for your prayers!

We are continuing to monitor the Immigration actions being taken by the administration through the ongoing Zoom meetings with legal representatives of the United States Council of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and Welcome US. The Humanitarian Parole Program remains under fire with uncertain consequences for all paroles here under the program, including the Bryiovskyis.

The constant anxiety the Bryiovskyis feel about their current fragile (but legal) US immigration status adds to their everyday fears about their family members left in Ukraine. They need our help. So, we ask that you continue to pray for them and their families.







A Lenten Invitation...

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2025, when we enter the 40 days of preparation for Easter. This is a season of repentance, and we are called to fast, to pray and to give alms. The activities, events, and prayer opportunities available at **St. Julie Billiart (SJB)** and **St. Peter (SP)** Catholic Churches, as indicated, are meant to be suggestions to assist in living out the Lenten

ASH WEDNESDAY

Lent begins with us hearing the words, "Repent, and believe in the Gospel." Ashes will be distributed March 5th during Masses at:

SP: 8:15 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. SJB: 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting (only one meal) and abstinence (refrain from meat).



During Lent, we remember the sacrifice of Christ on Good Friday and unite ourselves with that sacrifice through fasting, abstinence and prayer.

- We fast on the first day of Lent, Ash Wednesday, and the day Christ died for us, Good Friday. Fasting is for those age 18 to 59, unless you are pregnant or have an illness that could cause harm, e.g., diabetes. When we fast, only one full meal should be eaten that day. Two smaller meals could be eaten but they should not exceed one full meal.
- When we abstain from meat, we are voluntarily giving up something good, for our spiritual benefit. The practice of Abstinence is for everyone over the age of 14 on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Come and meditate on the final steps of Jesus as he journeyed to Calvary through the Stations of the Cross. We pray the **Stations every Friday in Lent at SJB: 12:00 p.m. and SP: 7:00 p.m.**




