

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners,

The word epiphany means to manifest or to appear. It combines two Greek words epi which means upon and phanio which means shine or appear. Mass readings today speak of things that shine, appear and reveal. From Isaiah the prophet we hear that "the glory of the Lord shines upon you" and that "you shall be radiant". St. Paul speaks of "the mystery" that "now has been revealed." In the gospel, it is a star shining in the sky that guides the magi to their destination.

All these things that shine and reveal point to Jesus. The gospel on Christmas day often describes the visit of shepherds to the stable in Bethlehem. On Epiphany we hear of Magi coming from the east to honor the one they call the "newborn king of the Jews." Their visit reveals that Jesus did not only come for the Jews. The visit of the Magi to Jesus and his mother Mary reveal that Jesus came for everyone: Jew and Gentile alike.

St. Paul calls this a hidden mystery now revealed..."to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit: that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel." (Ephesians 3:5b-6). The gospel calls everyone to Christ.

This truth is reiterated at the end of each gospel. Jesus commissioned his Apostles to "go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15) and to "make disciples of all nations." (Matthew 28:19a) The deepest identity of the Church is "missionary." Jesus came for everyone. The Church is charged with telling everyone about him.

Sometimes we need to be reminded that each of us have a part to play in bringing the person of Christ to the world. We may be tempted to leave it to formally trained missionaries sent to foreign lands. Or perhaps to the priests and religious because...well, that's their job!

The truth is that each of us has our own mission field.

- · For students, it is the classroom.
- · For parents, it is the home.
- · For people in the work force, it is the workplace.
- · For retirees, it is the discretionary time.
- · For the elderly, it is their homes or facilities.
- For religious, it is by their vows.
- For those in ordained ministry, it is among their flocks.

How we fulfill our duties, how we treat each other, how we serve the needy: these are the things that become the foundation of our witness to Christ. Our mission reminds us that we are not here simply to amuse ourselves. We are to grow in holiness and fruitfulness

As we celebrate the Epiphany of Jesus Christ, let us pray that we can embrace our own part in the missionary activity of the Church. Many aspects of our society and culture are darkened by sin and distraction. Let us be an epiphany of Christ, wherever we go, shining his light upon all people. Let's brighten up our world.
