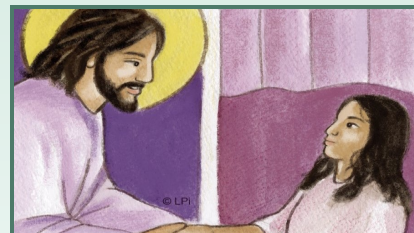

St. John wrote at the end of his gospel, *there are also many other things that Jesus did, but if these were to be described individually, I do not think the whole world would contain the books that would be written.* (John 21:25) I think of the millions of people that Jesus touched, perhaps less dramatically, but life-changing none the less. As we welcome Jesus in the Eucharist, let us confidently bring him our needs, knowing that power inexhaustibly flows from Him.
