Dear Parishioners.

Last Saturday Fr. Isidore and I went to the priesthood ordination of eight men for the Diocese of Cleveland at St. John the Evangelist Cathedral. We were greatly encouraged by the wonderful worship of a packed Cathedral and by the fact that the diocese now has eight new priests.

Though these men are a source of great hope for our local church, we need to remember that priests reaching retirement age (75) will outnumber those being ordained about 2 to 1. It is just a demographic fact. In the late 1970's and early 1980's, our diocese was ordaining around 15 priests a year.

I think a good response to our situation as a diocese ought to be twofold. First, we need to thank God for our newly ordained priests. Compared to many other dioceses in the United States, we are truly blessed. The second thing we need to do is to continue to ask the Lord of the harvest to send more laborers into his harvest! (Matthew 9:36). God our Father, hear our prayers!

Here are some of the special events that may be of interest to St. Julie Parishioners:

- 1. Monday, May 26 is Memorial Day. St. Julie Parish will be joining St. Peter Parish for this Mass at 9:00 a.m. Weather permitting, we will celebrate Mass just behind the Parish Center. At the conclusion of Mass, we will bless the cemetery. All are welcome.
- 2. Friday, May 30 is the annual Cruise-In Car and Driver Blessing and Ice Cream Social at St. Peter Parish. It is also part of the St. Peter 150th Year of Jubilee celebration. This family friendly event begins at 5:00 p.m. with old cars, refurbished cars and high-powered cars assembling in the back lot of St. Peter Parish. The car and driver's blessing will take place at 7:00 p.m. We will bless our everyday cars, as well as bikes and any other form of transportation as well as drivers. Ice cream (with toppings) and refreshments will be served in the gym right after the blessing. What's not to like? All are welcome.
- 3. On Saturday, May 31 St. Peter is having a moving sale. Fr. Isidore and I will be moving to the St. Julie Rectory on Wednesday, June 4. We have lined up a moving company for that day. If the renovation of the rectory is not completed by that time, we may be consigned to that place in speculative Catholic theology called "Limbo". Details about the moving sale on May 31 are in this bulletin. Come and see! You never know what you might find.

The plan for the St. Peter rectory is that it will first undergo asbestos abatement. When that is completed, the rectory will be demolished, hopefully the week of June 16. When the site is cleared and with proper approvals by the diocese and the City of North Ridgeville, construction on the hall and elevator connecting to the church will commence.

In today's gospel reading, Jesus answers these questions:

- 1. How do we show our love for God? By keeping his word.
- 2. How does the Holy Spirit help us? By teaching us and reminding of what Jesus told us.
- 3. Where can I find peace? Jesus gives us his gift of peace. It is not as the world gives, which comes and goes based on circumstances. The peace of Jesus is always offered to us. He is victor over death and sin.
- 4. Where is Jesus now? He has returned to the Father. And he will come back again at the end of time.

Obedient to Christ, assisted by the Spirit, living in Christ's peace, let us long for his coming again!


