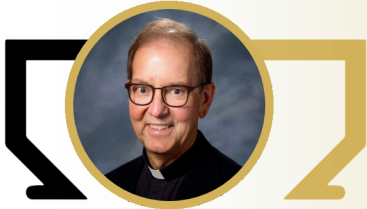

PASTOR'S LETTER



Beginning May 1 & 2, both St. Peter and St. Julie Parish will be moving the St. Michael the Archangel Prayer to the end of Mass. This tradition was initiated by Pope Leo XIII in 1884, in response to a vision of the spiritual warfare that would unfold in the coming decades. It was prayed after Mass until 1964. In 2018, Pope Francis encouraged the recitation of this prayer for the similar reasons as Pope Leo XIII. Parishes in our area have begun to do this before or after the Mass.

Its original position was immediately after Mass. Starting on May 1, we will have the St. Michael prayer recited immediately after the dismissal and before the closing song.

Dear Parishioners,

For we walk by faith, not by sight. (2 Corinthians 5:7) This short statement by St. Paul summarizes much of Christian life, even parish life. Last week I celebrated an outdoor Mass for St. Peter School fifth graders during their overnight learning experience at Camp Christopher. Though storms threatened, we pressed on. Hindered only by a bit of drizzle at the end, we finished the Mass.

We had a similar experience at St. Julie's. The weather report for the stick pickup last Saturday almost guaranteed rain between 12-2:00 PM. Though we had some light rain for twenty minutes or so, volunteers were able to work a solid 90 minutes. And let me give a special word of thanks to Dale and Teresa Chen, who began almost 2 hours earlier than the rest of us! We walk by faith, for unseen Christ promised, "I am with you always, until the end of the world." (Matthew 28:20)

Also, a special thank you to Sr. Sean Groh and Ms. Kelly Reed, the parish catechetical leaders for both parishes. They oversaw at each parish their respective Jesus Days for second graders who are making their First Communions this year. Also, a special thank you to Bridget Stalla, the St. Julie Grade 2 catechist and the St. Julie Grade 2 PSR class who are making their First Communion at the 11:00 AM Mass this Sunday, April 26. Congratulations First Communion Class. "...as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk with Him." (Colossians 2:6)

Last Sunday most of the pastoral staff of both parishes were doing Confirmation interviews. The St. Peter and St. Julie confirmandii will celebrate this Sacrament with Bishop Woost on Monday, May 11. Our students were well prepared, knowledgeable and enthused. Please keep them in your prayers.

Each parish celebrated weddings this past Saturday, April 25. Congratulations to Mr. and Mrs. Carlos and Sarah Delgado of St. Julie Parish and Mr. and Mrs. Samuel and Megan Kunkel of St. Peter Parish. May the Lord bless and prosper you and your future families.

Ted Lapponi, a parishioner at St. Julie Parish, asked me if he could do a weekly "fly over" of the St. Peter Event Center construction site. He would practice his drone skills and video editing. The parish would have a video log of each week's progress. I welcomed this "win-win" opportunity. A link to the first aerial video footage of the building is available on the St. Peter website.

Ted will also be preparing some aerial footage and overhead photos of St. Julie Parish. We will soon have them up on the St. Julie website. Thank you Ted! (If you are looking for aerial video or photography, Ted's contact information is at the beginning of each video.)

Blessing Box update: I took a closer look at the St. Peter blessing box. Apparently, the recent storms tore the door off the box. Hopefully it will be repaired quickly and be put in use again.

Finally, this is Good Shepherd Sunday. Let us be attentive to His voice and share in His abundant life.

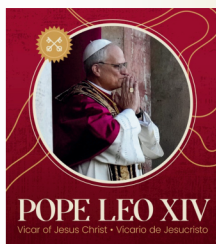

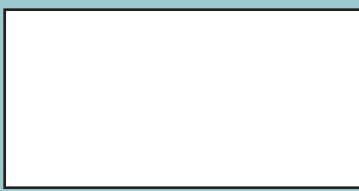

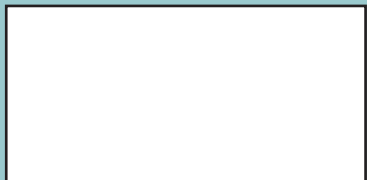
