

From the desk of Fr. Bob...

Dear Parishioners,

Earlier this week I met with the staff of St. Julie Parish. The purpose was to discuss upcoming plans for the 2023-2024 year.

It was a fruitful meeting. We did much calendar planning and did our best to coordinate the calendars of St. Peter Parish and St. Julie Parish. (This is not as simple as it sounds. It's hard enough getting an individual parish to set a calendar for the year without having groups bump into each other. Looking at two parish calendars is even more daunting.)

St. Peter and St. Julie Parish will be collaborating on a number of things in the coming year. Besides the Men's and Woman's Breakfasts, the St. Julie & St. Peter Ukrainian Welcome Circle, the Pro-Life initiatives (Pro-Life Committee and Walking with Mom in Need group), Penance Services and the Joint Parish Mission, the parishes will be collaborating on special events focused on the Years of Eucharistic Revival.

Parish life is the focus of the year 2023-2024 regarding Eucharistic Revival. St. Peter and St. Julie Parish will be looking to do at least these four things together:

- A five-week book study on Bishop Baron's book This Is My Body. This will be held on Saturday mornings from 10:00-11:30 a.m. beginning September 9. This book study will take place at St. Peter Parish.
- A five-week book study on a book to be determined. We are waiting to see what the National Eucharistic Revival Committee will be publishing in August of 2023. This study will begin on Saturday, January 6 from 10:00-11:30 a.m. at St. Julie Parish.
- The Corpus Christi Procession between the parishes on Sunday, June 2, 2024.
- Training and Commissioning of Home visitors: We will be forming teams to visit every registered household in both parishes. These team members will be trained to engage in light conversation and distribute a large envelope/bag that will have materials regarding the Eucharist, Mass and parish activities.

Also, it is my hope to have some parishioners from each parish to participate in the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis from July 17-21, 2024. I will be looking into this soon. I hear that thousands of people have already registered!

At this meeting we also discussed the ChristLife programs. <u>We</u> will be moving the first season of Discovering, Following and Sharing <u>Christ to St. Julie Parish for the fall sessions</u>. We are slated to begin on Monday, September 11 at 6:00. This the time that the dinner with Discovering Christ will begin. The program will conclude at 8:00 p.m.

It is my hope that many parishioners from both parishes will participate in Discovering Christ. Even beyond our parishes, <u>this</u> program can be helpful for those who have drifted from the faith or for <u>those who have no faith at all</u>. The title really says it all: Discovering Christ. Beginning with a free meal (what's not to like!) and a short song and prayer, the video presentations are timely and engaging. More information will be forthcoming and all will be welcomed!

This Saturday, St. Julie Parish buried one of its faithful and active members: Linda LaLonde. Linda died suddenly at home on July 12.

This diminutive woman had a big heart of love that she shared with everyone, beginning with her large family (nine living children and 25 grandchildren) and extending out to the people of St. Julie Parish. Linda was involved in Cursillo 50 years ago and was a daily Communicant. She labored for Pro-Life causes and sang in the St. Julie Saturday evening choir. Linda's smile and cheerful love will be missed. As we commend her to God, may she pray for us before His throne.
