PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners,

I recently came across this quote by St. Elena Guerra (+1914), recently canonized by Pope Francis in April of 2024:

Pentecost is not over. In fact it is continually going on in every time and in every place, because the Holy Spirit desired to give himself to all men and all who want him can always receive him, so we do not have to envy the apostles and the first believers; we only have to dispose ourselves like them to receive him well, and He will come to us as he did to them.

We celebrate Pentecost as an ongoing reality, not simply a historical event from the first century. The gift of the Spirit is at work now, empowering us to proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord. The Spirit is impelling us to cry out to God, "Abba, Father!" The Holy Spirit is drawing us into unity and equipping us to evangelize the world.

St. Cyril of Jerusalem (+386) described the Holy Spirit and his work like water: [Like water]...In the same way the Holy Spirit, whose nature is always the same, simple and indivisible, apportions grace to each man as he wills. Like a dry tree which puts forth shoots when watered, the soul bears the fruit of holiness when repentance has made it worthy of receiving the Holy Spirit. Although the Spirit never changes, the effects of his action, by the will of God and in the name of Christ, are both many and marvelous.

St. Basil (+379) described the Holy Spirit like the sunshine: Simple in himself, the Spirit is manifold in his mighty works. The whole of his being is present to each individual; the whole of his being is present everywhere. Though shared in by many, he remains unchanged; his self giving is no loss to himself. Like the sunshine, which permeates all the atmosphere, spreading over land and sea, and yet is enjoyed by each person as though it were for him alone, so the Spirit pours forth his grace in full measure, sufficient for all, and yet is present as though exclusively to everyone who can receive him. To all creatures that share in him he gives a delight limited only by their own nature, not by his ability to give.

As we enter into Ordinary Time, let us remember that Ordinary Time means living fruitfully in the power of the Holy Spirit. Let us continually pray, Holy Spirit, fill me!

Fr. Mitchell Carson was ordained last Saturday and had his Mass of Thanksgiving at St. Peter's on Sunday afternoon. Both liturgies were wonderfully inspiring events. Fr. Carson has been assigned as the Parochial Vicar at St. Joseph Parish in Avon Lake. Let us keep him in our prayers as he begins his priestly service to our Diocese.

Congratulations to Jon and Jessica Rook, married at St. Julie's on Saturday, May 16th.

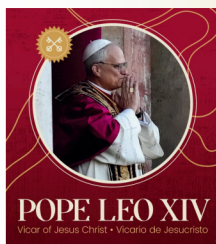

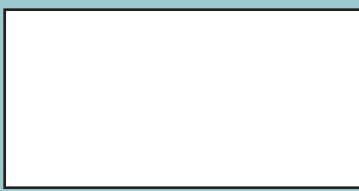

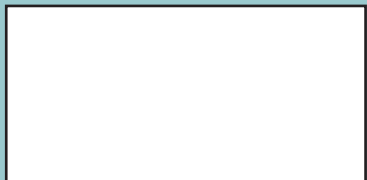
