Vote this Tuesday to Protect Life

Groups outside of Ohio are attempting to push through a proposed amendment to Ohio's constitution in November, which would eliminate parental consent in abortion decisions for minors, make abortion available for all nine months of pregnancy, and force Pro-Life groups to refer people for abortions. There is a special election this Tuesday, August 8 (Issue 1) which raises the threshold for changing our state constitution from 50% plus 1 vote to a 60% vote of the electorate. Making this change to the constitutional process in Ohio will help make the process more robust for changing our state constitution. A "Yes" vote on Issue 1 this Tuesday would make it more difficult for the anti-life, anti-family amendment to pass in November. Let us vote to protect both child and mother in all elections
