

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Dear Parishioners,

I am grateful for our Memorial Day Mass. Parishioners from St. Peter and St. Julie Parishes gathered at St. Peter Parish church (we were rained out of the Cemetery Mass) to offer Mass and remember those who gave their lives in defense of our freedom. May they rest in peace. Our next Civil Holiday is Independence Day. Mass on July 4 will be at 9:00 a.m. at St. Julie Parish.

I enjoyed seeing many of you later that morning in the South Central Park area. After planning and fundraising the City of North Ridgeville dedicated a beautiful Veteran's Memorial, located on the south side of Bainbridge, near Rt. 83. Names of Soldiers who gave their lives while serving in our military are memorialized. The Veteran's Memorial also has nine flags (six flags for each of each of the branches of the military: Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard and Space Force, plus a US Flag, State of Ohio Flag, and a POW flag). God's blessings to all people who made this memorial possible.

This is the Solemnity of the Body of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi Sunday. During these years of Eucharistic Revival, I pray that each of us grow in our devotion of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. Two ways to help grow that devotion are:

- 1. Today's Procession with the Blessed Sacrament from St. Peter Parish to St. Julie Parish. This prayerful family friendly witness to our faith serves to strengthen the faith of each of us. We will process to St. Julie Parish immediately after the Noon Mass. Please see details in today's bulletin. I hope that many of you can join us.
- 2. The second way would be to participate in the sevenweek video series on Jesus and the Eucharist. I watched one of the videos and I found it very well done. For more details, see the article in this bulletin.

This is the Catholic Charities follow up weekend. If you have not participated in this vital service for our needy brothers and sisters, I strongly encourage you to do so. Perhaps you were away for the winter or simply were not able to give last February. Now is the time. Envelopes are at the doors of the church.

This coming Friday is one of my favorite events at St. Peter Parish. Actually, it is three events. First, there will be a Cruise In. This will begin at 6:00 p.m. in the back parking lot of St. Peter Parish. (Hot dogs may be available!) At 7:00 p.m., we will have the annual Car and Driver blessing. St. Christopher medals will be available. Finally, immediately after the car (and other vehicles and modes of transportation) and driver blessing, there will be an Ice Cream Social in the St. Peter gym. St. Julie Parishioners are more then welcome to share in the fun.

Today's gospel is St. Mark's version of the Last Supper. This meal was the first century version of the Seder Meal that Jews celebrate on Passover. During this particular Passover Meal, Jesus added some rituals that have become the *Source and Summit* of the Christian life. From the time of the Last Supper, Christians believed that the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. This is Christ's presence among us. At the Mass, Jesus is our great High Priest, our offering to the Father, our nourishment, and our source of unity.

As we celebrate this Feast of our Lord, let us pray to grow in our awareness of Christ's Real Presence. And as we consume Him in Holy Communion, may we become what we eat and be Christ's Body on earth.


