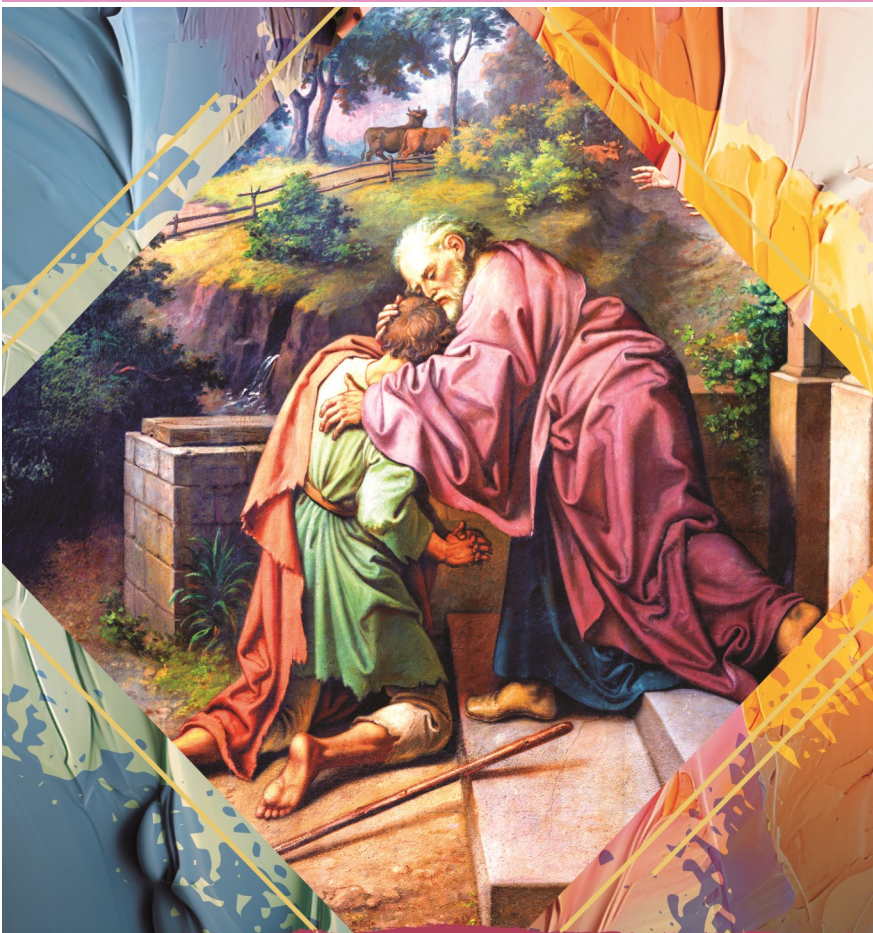

Dear Parishioner,

**The Sacrament of Penance is a gift from God to the Church.** Jesus Christ, on the Sunday night after he rose from the dead, breathed the Holy Spirit on his apostles and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them and whose sins you retain, are retained." (John 20:22b-23) The Lord Jesus knew that forgiveness of sins was essential to the health of his people, so he gave this authority to the Church immediately after he rose from the dead.

**Last week was Confession week.** Besides our three plus hours of confessions on Wednesday, we also heard confession on Sunday afternoon at St. Julie's for 90 minutes. As priests who desire to see people reconciled to God, this ministry is our joy. And in case you missed these opportunities, fret not. There is more. We will still offer this Sacrament on Saturday afternoons and on Wednesday mornings at St. Peter Parish. There will also be extra hours during Holy Week. Like the prodigal son in today's gospel, our Father welcomes you with open arms.

**Please keep our candidates for Confirmation in your prayers.** They will be having their interviews over the next couple of weeks. **Especially, please pray for the adults and youth that will be initiated into Christ and the Church at this upcoming Easter Vigil.** Especially pray for Dale Chan from St. Julie Parish, who has been preparing for the Easter Sacraments with the St. Peter Parish OCIA group. May they encounter the Lord in the Easter sacraments and remain faithful to Him!

**I have been getting more inquiries about getting marriages convalidated in the Church.** Fr. Isidore and I are glad to assist couples in these situations. Please do not hesitate to call us.

**This is Parish Mission Week! Frank Runyon is here** to lead us through our three-evening mission. I have heard that Frank Runyon's presentations of the gospels and his messages are very engaging. Please make every effort to participate. **As we give our time to the Lord, he will give us blessings in return.**

**This is Laetare Sunday.** Laetare is a Latin word that means *rejoice*. We rejoice as we pass the halfway point of Lent. **We especially rejoice because of the reconciling love of the Lord revealed to us in the Sacred Scriptures.**

Our first reading from the Book of Joshua summarizes the story of one of the most famous stories of Jesus-the prodigal son. **The LORD said to Joshua, "Today I have removed the reproach of Egypt from you."** Certainly, this is what the father did when his wayward son returned home. He clothed his shame with the finest robe. The sandals indicate that he was not a slave but a free person. The ring on his finger indicates that he was restored as a family member. His shame was removed.

Also from our first reading, the Israelites ceased to receive manna, the bread that sustained them on their journey. Why? **They have now arrived in their homeland and could eat its grain.** Similarly, in today's gospel, when the younger son returns, the father celebrates his return home with the slaughtering the fatted calf. So too our shame is removed through Baptism and subsequently through the Sacrament of Penance. We now have the privilege of feasting on Christ Himself in the Eucharist.

**Let us pray to always be grateful for the mercy that has found us.** This will keep us from becoming hardened like the elder brother. Our delight is not primarily in our earthly comforts but in our Lord and the brothers and sisters he reconciles to himself. **In Christ, Fr. Bob Franco**

## Week 4 Update

**We are now in Week 4 of the 40 Days for Life Spring Campaign, and there's exciting news to share: Reports continue to come in of the many babies whose lives have been saved from abortion! Praise God!!** Each baby saved also means that a mom and dad were spared the pain and suffering of participating in the death of their own child. **Your prayers are making a difference! Keep praying!**

**Around the U.S. and around the world, children are being saved from death by abortion because people are praying. Here's an account of how prayer and persistence saved the life of a child in Atlanta:**

*With God on your side, there is hope even in the most hopeless situations. That was the case with an abortion-bound woman in Atlanta, who refused information on alternatives to abortion and then got out of her car and began photographing Cathy--a tactic sometimes used to try to intimidate vigil participants. Cathy didn't give up. She simply shared the many ways her 40 Days for Life team could help. But the woman still entered the clinic. As the young mother left the abortion facility, she gestured to Cathy that she wanted to talk. "If you could help me find a job, I know I can have this baby," she said. Cathy made plans to meet with the young woman the next day to set her up with a job recruiter, joined her for an appointment at the local pregnancy help center, and reimbursed her for the money she spent on the ultrasound at the abortion facility. The mom has already had a number of abortions, but Cathy refused to allow the woman's initial response to get her down. And that perseverance paid off, breaking the cycle of abortion and protecting both mother and child from another abortion. "Praise God," Cathy said. "We had a baby saved today."*

**What a blessing to see how God is hearing and answering the prayers of His people!** Please pray for this mom, and all the moms and dads who choose life. Often the circumstances that brought them to the abortion facility are waiting for them when they return home. This is why prayers are so critical, and also why the amazing services provided by the pregnancy help centers are so important (for a list of local pregnancy help service centers, see [stjuliebilliart.org/moms-in-need](http://stjuliebilliart.org/moms-in-need).)

**This Thursday, you can join with fellow St. Julie Billiart parishioners to pray at the Planned Parenthood abortion mill in Bedford Heights** from 12noon to 1pm. Our prayers, at the very place where babies are being killed, provide God an opportunity to work in and through us for the benefit of all who enter. Meet at the St. Julie large parking lot at 11:15am.

**If you can't make it to Planned Parenthood, you can pray with fellow parishioners in the church, also on Thursday from 12noon to 1pm.**

**Another opportunity for prayer is to join with the St. Julie Billiart Rosary Group to pray the Rosary each Wednesday at 1:00pm in the church, followed by Eucharistic Adoration from 2-5pm.**

**Each Monday, St. Peter Church participates in 40 Days for Life by praying from Noon to 1pm at the Preterm abortion facility and simultaneously at St. Peter Church.** Those going to Preterm leave at 11:10 AM from the St. Peter front parking lot and return at 1:45 PM. Those praying at St Peter Church meet there at Noon and end at 1:00 PM.

God is working many miracles in response to the prayers of His people. Keep praying!
