

From the desk of Fr. Bob...

Dear Parishioners

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is often called *Good Shepherd*Sunday. Though we cycle through three sets of readings for the Fourth
Sunday of Easter, in each of the gospel readings Jesus refers to himself as the Shepherd.

This image of Jesus is comforting. Shepherds protect and feed the flock. They know each sheep in their flock by name. Jesus, as the Good Shepherd, laid down his life for the flock! How grateful we ought to be!

This Good Shepherd Sunday is also a time to pray for vocations to the priesthood. The shepherd like care of Jesus often comes to us through the human shepherds sent to us. Let us pray that God raise up shepherds after His own heart (see Jeremiah 3:15) who can serve the Diocese of Cleveland. I am grateful for the two men from North Ridgeville (Jim Livingston from St. Julie's who is on track to be ordained in 2025 and Mitchel Carson from St. Peter's, on track to be ordained in 2026). There are also two other young men connected with St. Peter Parish who have contacted our seminary system, one of which I believe will be entering this fall.

One of the prayers from the Third Week of Lent Evening Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours reads:

Father of all holiness, you gave us Christ as the shepherd of our souls; stay with your shepherds and the flock entrusted to them; do not leave the flock without the loving care of its shepherd. Do not leave your shepherds without an obedient flock to follow them.

We need to continue to pray that God grant us shepherds to care for God's flock. I also believe we need to pray for the flock of God too! We need people who want to listen to the voice of the Lord Jesus through the Church. One of the subtle temptations of our time is to make God in our own image and likeness. May God grant us shepherds after His own heart and sheep who listen more attentively to the voice of Jesus Christ more than the many voices of our age that promise happiness but leave us empty or in bondage.

This Saturday, May 6th, our St. Julie Parish Second Graders will be making their First Holy Communion. Please pray for them and their families this week. May God grant them his protection and peace and hearts open to welcome Jesus Christ, their Savior and Lord of All!

I want to thank Kelly Reed, our PSR Principal and Judy Cummings our PSR Second Grade teacher for all their efforts to prepare these children for First Holy Communion.




