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PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners,

The Auto-O-Rama has been the venue of some unique events in its 61-year history. However, I believe this was the first time that a large outdoor Mass, followed by a picnic, circus acts and face painting were combined with a movie!

I am grateful to Deacon Del, who lent his expertise to organizers from the Avon Catholic Community (Holy Trinity and St. Mary's), St. Julie Parish, St. Peter Parish and other parishes in planning this wonderful event. I am also grateful to God. The rain stopped in time for Mass and the clouds kept us from becoming uncomfortably hot. A good time was held by all!

Last Wednesday potential Catholics from North Ridgeville and beyond met for an orientation to the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA). We learned a bit about each other's story and the process of becoming Catholic. We will continue our journey of faith on Wednesday, September 2nd at 7:00 PM at St. Peter School. Walk-ins are welcome. In the meantime, if you are interested in becoming Catholic or simply have questions about the faith, please contact me or Sr. Sean (440-327-2201).

This Saturday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Because this solemnity falls on a Saturday, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation. However, to honor our Lady, St. Peter Parish will be having Mass at 9:00 AM. All are welcome. St. Julie Parish will be hosting the Men's Fellowship Breakfast that morning at 8:20 AM. All men are welcome for that event!

St. Peter School has its Spirit Sunday on August 16 at 1:00 PM. Parents and students will gather in the gym and then visit their classrooms. North Ridgeville Public Schools and St. Peter Catholic School begin on Thursday, August 20th. Students are starting to think, "The end is near!" Though summer break is ending, the goodness of school is beginning! And don't forget: the blessing of backpacks will take place at both parishes on the weekend of August 22-23rd.

I pray that we first profess with the apostles that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. By his grace, may we learn to navigate the storms of life with peace and wisdom.

"Walking with Moms in Need"- Car Donation

Have you ever considered donating your vehicle to help a mother in need? "Walking with Moms in Need" (WWMIN), in partnership with "I'm in Ministry," are in search of safe and mechanically sound used vehicles for mothers participating in our program.

Here is how the process works – First, notify the WWMIN program that you are interested in donating your vehicle. To proceed you must have the title (no liens or probate) for the vehicle. Second, we request permission to have our mechanic inspect the vehicle to look for structural and mechanical issues. Third, if the vehicle passes the inspection and the title is clean, "I'm in Ministry" will accept the vehicle, transfer the title, and complete any other required paperwork. Fourth, "I'm in Ministry" will provide you with a letter documenting your tax-deductible donation. Finally, the vehicle will be given to a mother we are serving in our "Walking with Moms in Need Ministry" at St. Julie / St. Peter, as well as one of our partnering parishes. 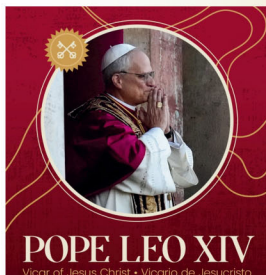
