

Dear Parishioner.

Last week began with a Super Sunday. Yes, there was a big football game. However, the Sunday was Super because it was World Marriage Sunday, World Day for the Prayer for the Sick and our Catholic Charities Appeal. I want to thank everyone for participating in the 2024 Catholic Charities Campaign. If you have yet to make your pledge, there are forms at the doors of the church. Please pick one up, follow the instructions, and bless your needier brothers and sisters.

One of the things that made last Sunday Super the St. Julie Volunteer Appreciation Banquet. This luncheon, with its Mardi Gras theme, was a time to acknowledge the many people who have served at St. Julie Parish in many ways. Again, thank you people of God for your service.

Please read over the flier in this week's bulletin regarding the Angel Scholarship Fund. This is a relatively painless way of supporting Catholic education. A gift to the Angel Scholarship Fund will be deducted off your taxes, dollar for dollar. Though you can direct your gift to any school in the diocese, I do encourage you to direct your gift to assist St. Peter School. My letter explains how it works in detail.

Last Monday and Tuesday Fr. Michael Denk led our two-day parish mission PRAY40DAYS. I believe everyone was inspired to pray more deeply and intentionally, striving to encounter the Lord. We learned about vocal prayer, meditative prayer, contemplative prayer, Lectio Divina, praying with scripture, relaxing in prayer, and how to pray like a pirate! This was one of my favorite ways: ARRR. We Acknowledge our feelings or problems, Relate them to the Lord, Receive his grace, blessing, direction, and Respond in an appropriate manner (gratitude, surrender, praise...)

We have been looking for someone to work with High School and Middle School youth at St. Julie and St. Peter Parishes. A little over a week ago I was approached by one of the teachers at St. Peter School, Niki Sherman. She expressed a desire to serve our parishes in this way. We talked about the possibilities of her doing this on a part time basis. Niki has accepted the challenge. She will continue her work at St. Peter School as well as work in a part time manner working with our youth.

Niki has worked with Vacation Bible School here at St. Peter's. God willing, her husband Del will be ordained into the permanent diaconate this coming May and Niki has participated in his formation. She is also very familiar with Damascus, the retreat center in central Ohio, that will be hosting our Confirmation class this year. We welcome Niki and pray that the Lord would guide, bless, and anoint her efforts to help our young people respond to the Lord during this season of their lives.

The new Maintenance Building at St. Peter Parish is taking shape. This would not concern St. Julie Parish at all except for this one fact. They will be connecting a water line for a hydrant this week that will entail the closing of Root Road for one night.

This will take place during a twelve-hour period from 6:00 p.m., Thursday, February 22 to 6:00 a.m., Friday, February 23. Root Road will be close to through traffic (Center Ridge Rd to Bainbridge) for those 12 hours. It will be a temporary inconvenience for a permanent improvement. I ask for your patience.

This is the First Sunday of Lent.

Our readings point us to baptism: Noah's

Ark, in which St. Peter says in our second
reading prefigures baptism. And our gospel
reading picks up with Jesus, right after he
was baptized, being impelled by the Spirit
into the desert. Let us remember, we are
baptized and that Christ is with us during our
earthly tests. He shares his victory with us.



Dear Parish Family,

In 2022, the State of Ohio passed legislation regarding donations to a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) which allows the citizens of Ohio to make donations to private schools and receive a dollar for dollar tax credit up to \$750 per individual or \$1500 per couple. The most recent legislation extends the timing of the donation to the filing due date of the related tax return. Therefore, if a taxpayer donates to an SGO by April 15, 2024, they can still elect to include the donation on their 2023 Ohio tax return.

Just what is a tax credit? Tax credits directly reduce the amount of tax you owe to the State of Ohio. A tax credit results in a greater tax benefit than a tax deduction. A tax credit is a dollar-for-dollar reduction of your tax liability whereas a tax deduction provides a "cents on the dollar" reduction. For example, a tax credit valued at \$750 lowers your tax liability by the corresponding \$750. To know if you have a State of Ohio tax liability to apply this tax credit against, you need to look at your State of Ohio income tax return and if the amount on line 10 is greater than the amount you donated, your donation should have a state tax benefit to you. You may donate more than \$750/\$1,500 but the tax credit is capped at \$750/\$1,500.

The Diocese of Cleveland has organized the Angel Scholarship Fund to assist Catholic schools in the Diocese of Cleveland to take advantage of this tax credit. It is quite simple. Fill out the form and donate to Angel Scholarship fund. You are able to designate which school will receive your donation. (I strongly encourage you to designate St. Peter Parish School [North Ridgeville] as the school that will benefit from this tax credit.) The Diocese will provide you with a receipt for your donation which you should provide to your tax preparer.

I thank you for considering the Angel Scholarship Fund. I pray God's blessings be with you and your loved ones.
