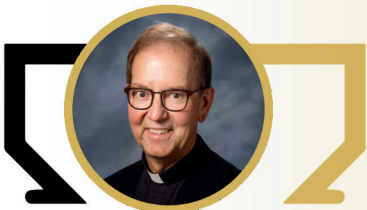

## PASTOR'S LETTER

**Dear Parishioners,**

Last Sunday the people of St. Julie and St. Peter Parish processed with the Blessed Sacrament from St. Peter to St. Julie Parish. God blessed our area with a beautiful and breezy 80° to process through our city with Jesus Christ. I heard rumor of one Facebook post that wondered, "Why is there a parade on Center Ridge Road with everyone following a person carrying a Cross?"

We gave testimony to our faith in Jesus Christ and his ongoing Sacramental Real Presence in our midst. I am grateful for the 74 people who participated in our procession and those who joined us at St. Julie Parish for Mid-Afternoon Prayer, Benediction and refreshments. I am also grateful for all who organized the procession as well as the City of North Ridgeville Police Department, who assisted everyone crossing major intersections.

The update of the St. Peter campus continues. New windows were installed in the Parish Center, replacing the original windows (from 1962). Also, lots of cinderblock was laid this week at the construction site. St. Joseph, Patron of Workers, pray for us!

As mentioned in last week's bulletin, the Cycling Saints will be cycling from Oberlin to Kipton this Sunday afternoon at 2:30. Please meet at the Butternut Ridge Rd. parking area along the North Coast Inland Trail (44342 Butternut Ridge Rd., Oberlin. The ride is about 20 miles. All are welcome.

I will be taking my annual retreat this week from Monday afternoon through Friday afternoon. I will be on the campus of Franciscan University of Steubenville. This is a retreat for priests, deacons and seminarians. The stated goal is: Find Rest in the Lord. Though I have some responsibilities with an organization called Fraternity of Priests (which will be having some meetings during this retreat), pray that I hear the Lord and will be refreshed by His presence.

This is our first foray into Sunday Ordinary Time readings since February 14-15. These texts of Sacred Scripture speak of God's heart and plan, as well as our part in fulfilling that plan. The Lord's heart is on display in our gospel:

At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. (Matthew 9:36)

The heart of Jesus is one of compassion for the troubled and abandoned. One way or another, all of us qualify. We need God's mercy. In our second reading, St. Paul reminds us how God's mercy was given to the world: God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

The message of the gospel is the kingdom. God reigns even over sin and death. This Good News needs to be communicated to the whole world.

Jesus did not try to minister to the crowds alone. From his followers he authorized twelve Apostles to continue this mission. They passed on this authority to others.

Through the Church's ordained ministers and through the gifts of the Spirit given to all the faithful, the Church's mission continues. May each of us do our part.

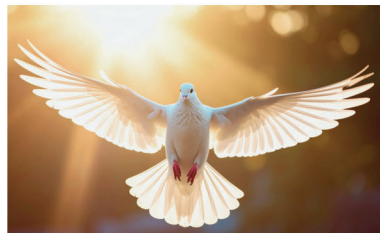

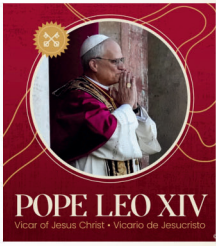

## CALL 9-1-1 IMMEDIATELY IF:

- **Breathing problems** (shortness of breath)
- **Chest pain** (lasting 2+ minutes)
- **Bleeding** that will not stop
- **Sudden confusion** or change in mental status
- **Choking**

## WHAT TO DO (4 STEPS)

1. **Stay Calm:** Take a deep breath.
2. **Call 9-1-1:** Give your location, name, and nature of the emergency.
3. **Provide Info:** Explain the person's health conditions and medications.
4. **Do Not Hang Up:** Stay on the line until dispatcher tells you to.

## 💡 Tips for Safety

- ✓ **Keep This Flyer Visible:** Tape this flyer to the refrigerator or near the home phone.
- ✓ **ICE Number:** Save an "In Case of Emergency" (ICE) contact in your cell phone.
- ✓ **Medical ID:** Consider wearing a medical alert bracelet.
