

## *From the desk of Fr. George...*

Greetings Parishioners and friends of St. Julie's,

Today is Ascension Sunday. While many of us remember this feast as Ascension Thursday - 40 days after Easter - in the Diocese of Cleveland (as well as many others), it was moved to Sunday so that it could be celebrated by as many of the faithful as possible.

As the Easter Season for 2022 begins its final week, the first reading provides the account of Jesus being lifted up and a cloud taking Him from the sight of the apostles. Two men dressed in white garments suddenly stood beside them and spoke: *"Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven."* Their words are an assurance that Jesus will come again and, in some way, a challenge for them to get busy doing what they had been prepared to do. Each of us shares in that challenge... to do the work of Christ.

Jesus continues to be with us. Although this weekend indicates the near end of the Easter Season, we are always a people of resurrection and joy. Next Sunday is Pentecost - the great birth of the Church and of the Holy Spirit descending upon the Apostles. Our liturgical celebrations remind us of not only events of history, but the all-encompassing offerings of our faith.

**This weekend - Memorial Day - we pause to remember those who have given their lives in service/defense of our nation. The gift they have offered to us has given us life in many ways. Pray for them... and for all who still serve. Teach your children and grandchildren the importance of this day!**

*On a personal note: My heart procedure did not take place last week as planned. The cardiologist secretary forgot to file for pre-approval, so it was denied and cancelled. They are now filing an appeal which should be processed sooner than the month which was lost waiting. I still need the procedure, so keep on praying!*

## **Vacation Bible School June 13-17**


