Dear Parishioners,

Last Wednesday St. Peter and St. Julie Parishes treated those who care for our flower beds to a dinner in the Galilee Room of St. Peter Parish. It was only appropriate for those who do gardening at our parishes to be treated with food from the Olive Garden.

I am grateful for those who labor to keep our grounds beautiful. I shared with our gardening teams that *beauty* is one of the characteristics of God. Like unity, truth, and goodness, beauty attracts us to God. **May the Lord bless the work of these hands as they seek to beautify His grounds.**

**PSR registration has opened.** This is sort of an open enrolment season. Students from St. Julie Parish and St. Peter Parish can enroll in either PSR program. St. Julie Parish also has a family PSR program available. Information is online at either parish website or in the bulletin.

**VBS is around the corner and registration continues.** To register for *True North* or to volunteer to assist with the program, please see the bulletin.

**There is a Eucharistic Holy Hour and Concert this evening Sunday, July 20, at St. Peter Parish.** Their music director, Alex Kostritsa, has prepared an uplifting and joy-filled time of song and prayer.

**2025 is a Jubilee Year for the whole Catholic Church.** The Diocese of Cleveland has designated a number of pilgrimage sites in the area. Fulfilling the appropriate requirements, pilgrimages to these sites enable one to obtain a plenary indulgence. Pilgrims will carpool from St. Peter's on Wednesday, July 30<sup>th</sup>, at 9:30 a.m. and return by 1:30 p.m. In addition to having some quiet time of prayer, we will hear a brief talk about St. Ann, attend Mass, and pray the St. Joseph Novena. Confessions will also be available. Please register at <https://www.stpeternr.org/roamin-catholic-shrines>, no later than July 27<sup>th</sup> if you plan to participate.

**Here are some themes to look for in this Sunday's readings:**

1. **Hospitality**—both Abraham and Martha provide hospitality for their guests. Yet the gospel reading points out: attention to the guest trumps impressing the guest.
2. **God**—Three "men" drop in on Abraham, who recognizes this as a divine visitation. In the light of Christian Tradition, this scene has become a meditation on the Holy Trinity. In the gospel, Martha attends to the human needs of Jesus, while Mary listens to God's words from His lips.
3. **Priorities**: In the gospel, Jesus tells Martha that Mary has chosen the better part. This phrase "the better part" challenges us to keep Jesus first in our lives. Work, career, leisure, family, friends, even hospitality are important. However, the Lord Jesus is first and puts the rest of these aspects of life in their proper order.

Finally, I encourage you to keep our former pastors in your prayers. Retirement has been referred to as one's "golden years." However, as most retirees know, these years come with a host of new challenges, especially health issues. May our retired pastors know the support of our prayers during this season of their lives.
