

Next Sunday will be a Super Sunday. Yes, there will be a Super Bowl football game. And yes, most of America will press the pause button on the rest of life and go to some sort of gathering to watch the game, eat tailgate food, and rate the TV ads. And yes, Taylor Swift will probably be sitting a loge with the Kelce family.

However, there is another reason that next Sunday will be a Super Sunday. It can be summed up on two words: Catholic Charities. Each parish will be in our diocese will be making the Annual Catholic Charities Appeal to its parishioners. The theme of this year's appeal is Transformed by Love. The monetary goal of the appeal this year is \$15 million dollars, which will support almost 400,000 people who will somehow benefit from this appeal.

However, the real goal of this appeal is in its theme. We are Transformed by Love not only when we hear God's word proclaimed and welcome Christ in the Eucharist. And speaking about prayer: Jesus is very busy in today's gospel. After healing Simon Peter's mother-in-law, he brings healing and liberation to the town that gathered after sunset (when the Sabbath officially ended). The next day, Jesus tells his disciples that they cannot get settled in Capernaum. He had to press on to other towns and villages to proclaim the gospel there and bring them healing and deliverance.

In between these busy acts of ministry, Jesus prayed. It is in prayer that Jesus was strengthened to preach the gospel, heal the sick and resist the temptation to get comfortable. He did not wait for people to come to him. Jesus went out to them. May we do the same!


