

Dear Parishioners,

God is good, all the time; all the time, God is good, and that is His nature. Today is a joyous day as we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles, followers, friends of Jesus, great preachers of the gospel, missionaries, and leaders. God gave us these saints that we may learn from their life of witness on how to become saints. Saints Peter and Paul are often referred to as two of the great "Pillars of the Church." They each played an incredibly essential role in the establishment of the early Church. And though each of their roles was essential and foundational, their roles were as different as individuals.

Who is Peter the apostle? Peter was a family man, a local fisherman, uneducated, and guite ordinary. From what we know about him prior to being called by Jesus, there was nothing that made him uniquely qualified to become one of the pillars of the new Church to be established by the Son of God. Jesus simply called him, and he responded. In the Bible, Apostle Peter, originally named Simon, was one of Jesus' twelve closest disciples and a prominent figure in the early Christian church. Known for his strong faith and leadership, he was also prone to impulsiveness and even denied Jesus three times during his trial. Peter was known from the Greek word Petros, meaning "stone" or "rock." Like Paul, Peter is believed to have been crucified in Rome around 64 or 67AD, during the reign of Emperor Nero. He was crucified upside down because he felt he was unworthy to be crucified in a manner similar to Jesus.

Who is Paul the apostle? Paul, also known as Saul of Tarsus, was a prominent figure in the early Christian church, known as one of the most important figures after Jesus. He was a Roman citizen, a Jew by descent, and a prolific writer of the New Testament. Initially a persecutor of Christians, he famously converted to Christianity after an encounter with Jesus. He then became a missionary and influential teacher, spreading the gospel throughout the Mediterranean. After his conversion, Paul the Apostle faced significant persecution, including imprisonment, beatings, before eventually being executed in Rome. According to tradition and some early Christian writings, Paul was eventually beheaded in Rome around 67 AD, likely under the reign of Emperor Nero.

As we celebrate the solemnity of these two great apostles in our local church here in North Ridgeville, let us appreciate all they did. The Apostles Peter and Paul are commemorated and given the honor they deserve because of their commitment to Jesus and their ministry. Both were

martyred in Rome in the first century. They assiduously worked for the spread of the good news, not only to the people of Israel but to all the nations as well. They were aware of the consequence of following Jesus and still risked their lives in the process, gladly pouring out their blood in loyalty to their Master, the Lord Jesus Christ. As Paul so eloquently stated in his second epistle to Timothy, they courageously fought the good fight, finished the race, and kept the faith (2 Timothy 4:7). God rewarded them, making them great saints.

Let us pause for a moment today and reflect deeply about our own call to be witnesses of Christ in our modern world, with so many good things and challenges of our time. I believe you and I have been called by our Lord to a unique mission within our Church family. God wants to use us to reach certain people with the Gospel as He did with Saint Paul. And like Saint Peter, God wants to continue to establish His Church upon you and your faith. If we choose to commit ourselves to this mission, the preaching of the Gospel and the rock foundation of our Church will remain strong within our day and age. In concluding, let us Reflect upon these two holy and unique pillars of our Church. As you do, ponder how God may want to use you to continue their mission here at St. Peter or St. Julie Billiart and in other parts of the world. Saints Peter and Paul, pray for the faithful of St. Peter and St. Julie Billiart Parishes.



We continue to be inspired by all of the support you have given and ask for your continued prayers for the Bryiovskyis and some clarity for their immigration status.




