

Dear Parishioners,

I recently visited a person from one of the local nursing homes who was in the hospital. At his bedside, his daughter began to share how easy it is to forget that our earthly life is short, and that eternity is long...like forever. She recognized how easily we get our priorities mixed up. We are too serious about inconsequential things and neglect those things that are truly important.

The season of Advent is a good time to look at our priorities. On the one hand, our culture tries to focus our attention on the perfect gift. On the other hand, the Church calls us to recognize the gifts we have in Christ Jesus and prepare our lives for his coming.

The First Sunday of Advent always focuses our attention on the return of the Lord on the Last Day. It is the necessary corrective for being too serious about inconsequential things and things that we have no control over. As we enter this season of Advent, let us ready our lives for the coming of the Lord. By reordering our priorities, and making a good confession, we will be ready to meet the Lord and celebrate his birth with real joy.

The Solemn Feast of the Immaculate Conception is normally on December 8. However, because this falls on the Second Sunday of Advent, this Solemnity has been transferred to Monday, December 9. Often, when these sorts of Solemnities are on a Saturday or Monday, they are no longer obligatory. However, the Vatican's Dicastery for Legislative Texts, which clarified a request from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. noted that "the feast must be observed as a day of obligation on the day to which it is transferred." So, the Solemn Feast of the Immaculate Conception is now a Holy Day of Obligation on Monday,

December 9. Holy Day Masses will be on Monday only. Masses at St. Julie Parish will be 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Masses at St. Peter Parish will be at 8:15 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

As we journey through Advent, may Our Lady help us keep our priorities in order.


