Dear Parishioners,

Our pilgrimage ended 10 days ago. We offered prayers at many holy sites in Rome, San Giovanni Rotondo, and Assisi for the intentions we brought with us as well as for our parishes in general. We had some happy surprises along the way and only missed one of our scheduled tours. (The King and Queen of England bumped us from the Sistine Chapel when we were slated to visit it.)

One of the major basilicas we visited in Rome was St. John Lateran, the Pope's Cathedral in Rome and the first officially sanctioned Catholic Church in Rome. When November 9th falls on a Sunday, as it does this year, it is celebrated by the Roman Catholic Church throughout the world.

The basilica was founded in 324, shortly after Christianity was legalized in 313 by Emperor Constantine. Its official name is *Archbasilica of the Most Holy Savior and Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist at the Lateran*. The name reflects the history of the Cathedral. Originally named after Christ the Savior, it was renamed after St. John the Baptist when an elaborate baptistry was added in the 10th century. Pope Lucius II named it after St. John the Evangelist in the 12th century. Both saints became copatrons of the basilica. St. John Lateran is still the Pope's official cathedral because it houses the *cathedral*, the official chair of the bishop of a diocese.

There are six Papal Basilica's in the world. St. Peter, St. Paul outside the Walls, St. Mary Major, and St. John Lateran are in Rome. The other two papal basilicas are in Assisi: St. Francis Basilica and Our Lady of the Angels. Our pilgrimage was privileged to visit all six of these basilicas during this trip.

If you would like to hear more about our trip, I will be giving a presentation that will include pictures, on Friday, December 5, 7:00 p.m. Details will follow and all are welcome.

Because this is the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, our readings give us images of the Church. Our gospel reading describes the zeal that Jesus had for the Temple in Jerusalem. How much more zeal the Lord must have for his Church! St. Paul describes the Church as his Body. He reminds us that our own bodies are the dwelling place of God in the Spirit. Therefore, our thoughts, words, deeds, intentions, and motives ought to be animated by the Holy Spirit. We belong to Christ. As individuals and as the Church, we must steer clear of sin and scandal that have often tarnished people's experience of the Church.

Ezekiel describes the Temple as the source of life-giving waters. How much more the Church of Jesus Christ! Animated and guided by the Holy Spirit, the Church is the quench of the spiritual thirst of humanity. By its proclamation of Jesus Christ and good deeds of its members, the Church is to bring healing and salvation to the nations.

Lord Jesus, help us become what you have called us to be!

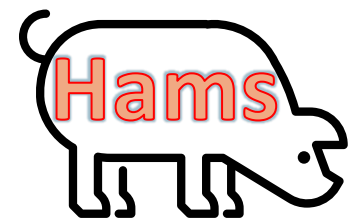
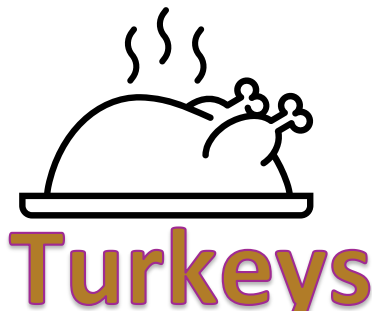

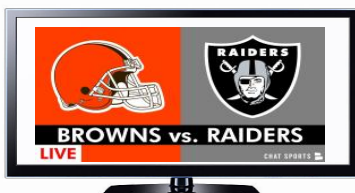
