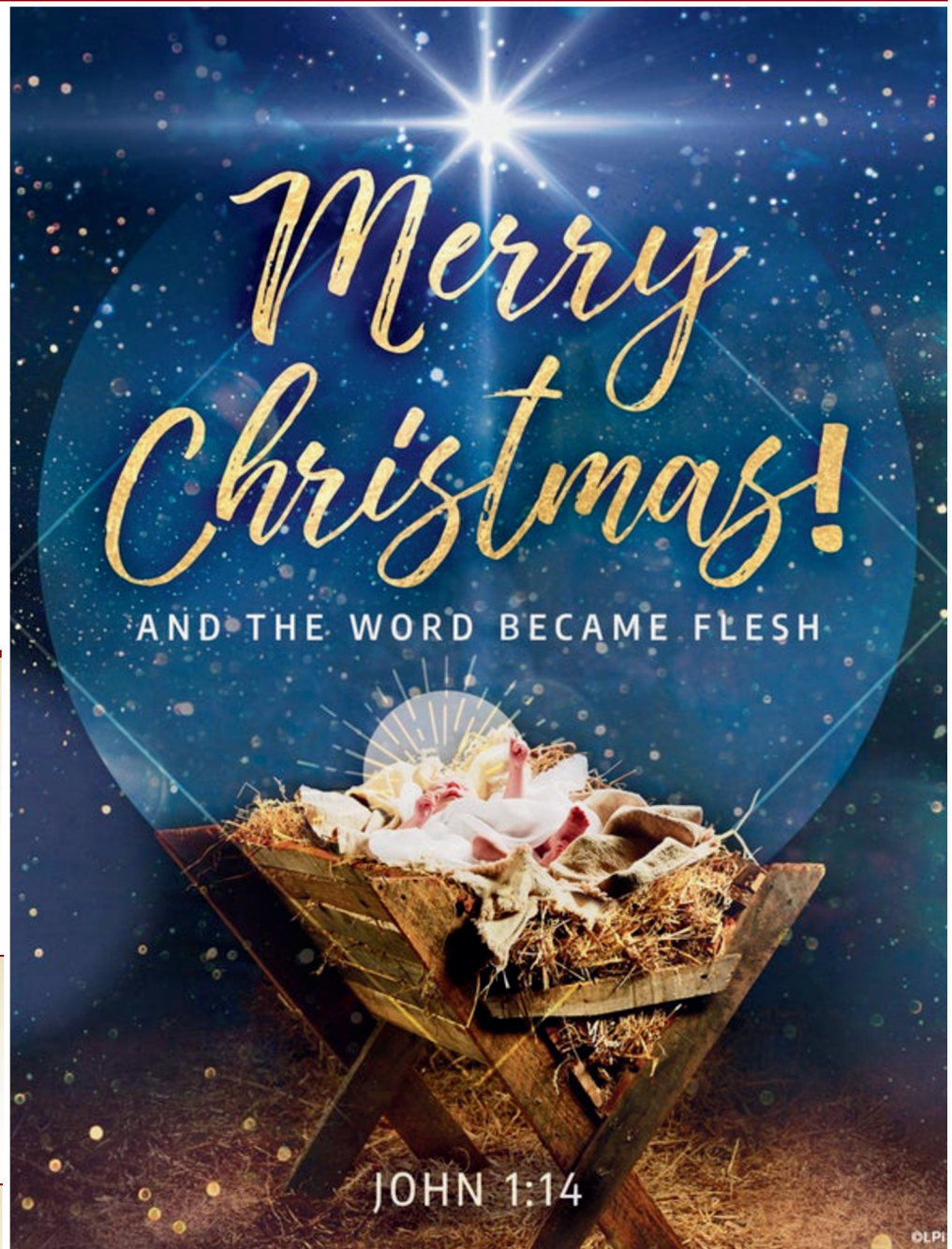

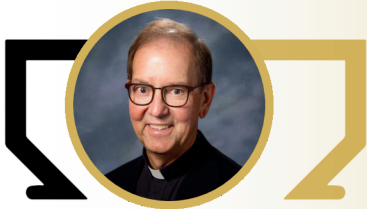

Dear Parishioners,

One of my childhood memories is listening to Andy Williams sing, It's the Most Wonderful Time of the Year. In my youth, I did find Christmas a wonderful time of the year for most of the reasons listed in the song: parties, caroling and even mistletoeing. As I have gotten older (OK-a lot older!), I still find "wonder" in the Christmas season. However, my sense of wonder is based on the event that underlies trimmings of the season: God became man and was born of the Virgin Mary in a sleepy little town called Bethlehem.

This event is the basis of the Good News. And this news is truly the G.O.A.T. (For those less acquainted with sport terms: Greatest of All Time.)

- If we recognize human pride as the root of earth's problems; we see God humbling himself and becoming a man. He is the antidote for our pride.
- If we acknowledge that human loneliness is endemic, we see in Jesus Emmanuel, a name which means "God is with us". Though unseen and often unfelt, God is close to us.
- If we recognize poverty as problematic, we see the Son of God born in a stable! He dignifies poverty and unsettles the wealthy.
- If we are disheartened by a world that seems hopelessly divided and polarized, we need to recognize that poor Jewish shepherds and wealthy Gentile Magi showed up at Bethlehem, reminding us that Jesus Christ came for us all.
- If we sometimes question our worth, God valued our humanity so much he became one! And he did so to forgive our wrongdoing and make us God's children.
- And if we seem to be without direction and find life pointless, Jesus Christ is the ultimate compass who give meaning and direction to life.

Jesus is truly the G.O.A.T. and the G.O.A. Eternity!

As we enter this wonderful season, let us seek to be, above all, bearers of Christian love. We may experience some snafus. Not everything may unfold according to plan. In fact, some things may just plain unravel! That's OK. Christ born in a stable, not a sterile birthing unit. He is not averse to messiness. If we try to forget ourselves and bring love into our families and Christmas gatherings, Christ is among us. As Micah prophesied years before the birth of Jesus Christ, "He shall be peace." (Micah 5:4a)

I wish each of you and your loved ones a blessed and joy filled Christmas. May the peace of Christ pervade your Christmas gatherings and, I pray, fill our world in new ways.
