Dear Parishioners,

The St. Julie campus is getting some updating. Last month we seal coated and striped the parking lot. This month we will be replacing the garage doors on the rectory side of the campus. I am also looking into turning the guest room in the rectory into more of a suite. Basically, that means adding a full bathroom in the rectory. Fr. Isidore and I hope to be moving over to the St. Julie rectory in the next six months or so.

The campus at St. Peter's is beginning to look a little different. Since the new maintenance building has been completed, I was able to have the old garage taken down. In due time, that corner of our property will include a new space for our dumpster and more parking.

In the meantime, plans continue for a new hall and elevator at St. Peter Parish. The design plans are being completed. Next steps will include getting a bid on the project and then speaking with the Diocese of Cleveland about our next steps.

The rectory at St. Peter Parish will be torn down to accommodate the new hall and elevator. This is why Fr. Isidore and I will be moving to St. Julie Parish. Pray that these projects come to fruition in a timely manner.

On the weekend of July 27-28, I preached about why we ought to go to Mass. Part of the focus of that homily was on the Lord's Day, in a sense the eighth day when Jesus rose from the dead and began the re-creation of this world.

The Church also summons us to Mass on a few other days during the year. We call them *Holy Days of Obligation*. Granted, the title is not too inviting. However, these special days highlight special events in the unfolding of God's plan.

This week we celebrate one of those days. The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is on Thursday, August 15. This feast day honors the Blessed Virgin Mary as the first one, after Jesus Christ, to share in the glorification of our humanity at the end of time.

And rightly so that Mary should be the first to share the glory of her Son in a full way. She does so not because of her physical relationship to Jesus. In truth, it was because of her complete and faithful fulfillment of God's will that she now shares in the glory of her Son.

The discipleship of Mary is demonstrated throughout her earthly life. The Archangel Gabriel addressed her as "full of grace" and announced that she would become the mother of the Son of God. Mary surrendered fully to God's plan and then demonstrated her evangelistic heart by bringing Jesus to her kinswoman, Elizabeth, and to the forerunner of the Messiah, John the Baptist.

After raising Jesus in Nazareth and inciting his first miracle at Cana, Mary then followed Jesus in his public ministry. **And when most of his apostles fled from Jesus after he was arrested, Mary, along with the apostle John and two other women, followed Jesus to the Cross.**

As St. Paul said, If we die with Him, we shall live with Him. (2 Timothy 2:11). While Jesus was physically dying on the cross, Mary was dying in just about every other way. **It is fitting that she who suffered with her Son in a most complete way, should share in this glorified presence in heaven.**


