## *From the desk of Fr. Bob...*

Dear Parishioners,

**Jesus Christ has been raised from the dead!** Amid all the disappointments of life, Jesus Christ is our never-failing hope. St. Augustine put it this way: We shared with Christ our humanity so that he could do the one thing as the Eternal Word that he was not able to do: die. Now He shares with us the one thing that we are unable to do apart from him: live eternally.

**Let us pray that the reality of Jesus raised from the dead permeate our souls ever more deeply.** Our world, filled with its setbacks and reversals, its brokenness and evil, has been redeemed by the Son of God. Let us embrace this reality and bring hope to our world.

**I am grateful to all the people who made the celebrations of this past Holy Week meaningful.** Many of our parishioners served our parish by embracing their liturgical roles (readers of scripture, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, servers). Others served as ushers and greeters. Still others assisted by decorating and redecorating for the different celebrations of Holy Week. And of course, we are all deeply grateful for Danny O'Brien and the music ministry at St. Julie's, who made and continue to make, our liturgical celebrations moving and meaningful.

One more word of gratitude: I am grateful for the small but mighty crew of volunteers who gathered at Noon on Palm Sunday to begin the cleanup of limbs and branches in the wooded areas of St. Julie's. Your labors will make caring for the property, especially cutting the grassy areas, much easier.

And along those lines, with planting season around the corner, St. Julie Parish is looking for a few more gardeners who can assist in caring for one of the flower beds around the church and rectory. If you are interested in exercising your green thumb, please call Pat or Amy at St. Julie's rectory and sign up for the flower bed team. We will have a meeting at the end of the month and assign flower beds.

**This coming Sunday, April 16, is Divine Mercy Sunday.** Inspired by the Diary of St. Faustina, the first canonized saint of the new millennium, this hour honors our Lord's greatest attribute: mercy. In her diary, St. Faustina indicated that the Lord Jesus asked that a special Holy Hour be offered on the Second Sunday of Easter, now called Divine Mercy Sunday. Our sister parish in North Ridgeville, St. Peter's, will be having a Divine Mercy Eucharistic Holy Hour at 3:00 p.m. in the Church. The Holy Hour will consist of Exposition, Scripture reading, silence, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, the Litany of Mercy and Benediction. All are welcome.

One scheduling note. Though this does not affect St. Julie's Parish directly, St. Peter Parish will be changing Saturday evening Vigil Mass from **5:00 p.m. Mass to 4:00 p.m.** This will allow Catholics in North Ridgeville an option for the Saturday Vigil Mass: 4:00 p.m. at St. Peter Parish and 5:00 p.m. at St. Julie Parish. This change will take place on July 1, 2023.

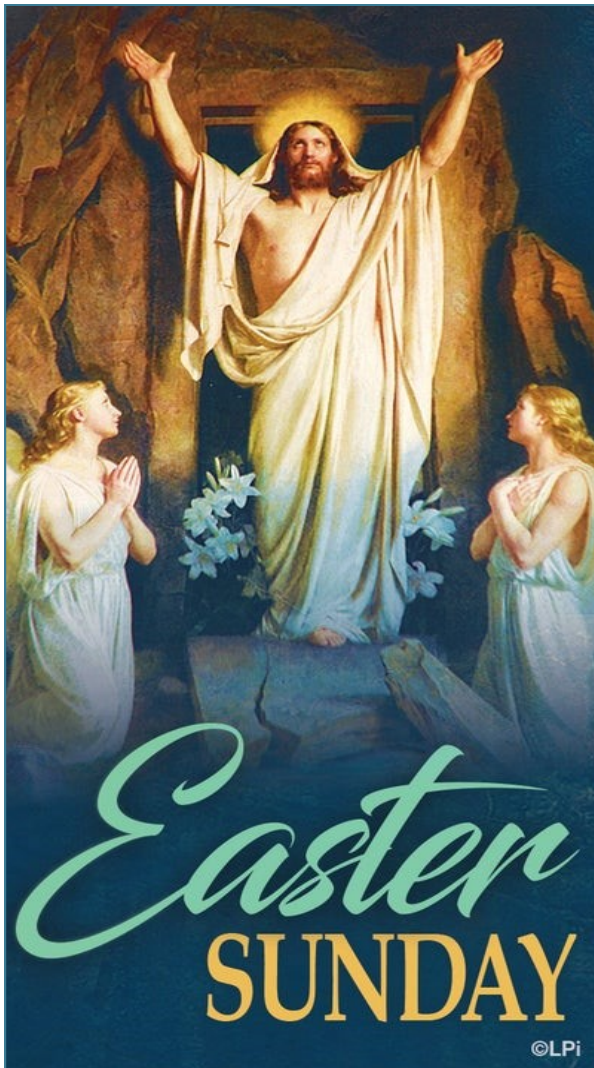

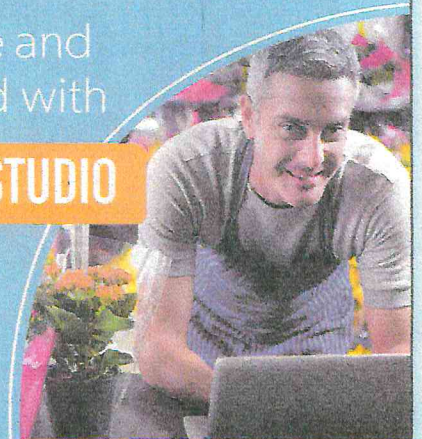
