

On December 17, Deacon John Rivera passed away at the age of 85 after a short illness. Married to his wife Dolores for 62 years, they raised six children. He worked in the Cleveland steel mill until his retirement.

Having heard the call to Holy Orders, he completed the formation program for the Diocese of Cleveland and was ordained to the Diaconate in 1987. Deacon John served our diocese at St. Augustine Parish, St. Julie Parish, the prisons in Grafton and the Cursillo program,

Deacon John was a man of humility and devotion. With cheerful trust in the Lord, he humbly accepted life as it came to him. Deacon John also had a great devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe, which I witnessed this firsthand when he came with me on a pilgrimage to the Guadalupe shrine in Mexico City in 2014.

We pray that Deacon John rest in peace. Let us also pray that Dolores and his family know the comfort and peace of Christ during this season of loss.

Today is the Feast of the Holy Family. During the pilgrimage I led in October, three pilgrimage sites highlighted the importance of family life. The first site was an unexpected visit to the Church of St. Augustine in Rome. St. Augustine was a brilliant, but wayward young man, who was converted at the age of 32 through the preaching of St. Ambrose and the prayers of his mother, St. Monica. Eventually, Augustine became the bishop of Hippo in Norther Africa and died there in 430. St. Monica referred to Augustine as "the son of my tears", so earnest was her prayer for him.

Though this church was named for St. Augustine, the church houses the mortal remains of St. Monica, who died near Rome. Our pilgrimage group took some time to invoke the intercession of St. Monica for our wayward family members.

A few days later, our pilgrim group came to the city of Loreto. Inside the Basilica of the Holy House of Loreto is the house of the Holy Family. There are two traditions as to how it ended up in Loreto, Italy. On tradition is that angels carried the house from the Holy Land to Loreto during the 13th century to protect it from Islamic soldiers. The second tradition was that an aristocratic family named Angelos had the house transported by boat to Loreto. It was a special place for our pilgrim group to pray for the renewal of our personal families.

The next day I was praying before the San Damiano Cross in Assisi. It was from this Cross that St. Francis heard the Lord say, "Francis...rebuild my Church." I thought of another church that needs to be reuilt: the domestic church, the Christian family.

On this Holy Family Sunday, we pray for all families, especially our young families. May they take up the practice of weekly Mass, family meals and family prayer. Jesus, Mary and Joseph: pray that families be rebuilt in our day!
