# St. Julie Billiart Parish

From the desk of Fr. Bob...

Dear Parishioners.

This Tuesday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. Though this event is not recorded in Sacred Scripture, the second Church referred to Mary as the New Eve. As the first Eve consented to Satan's temptation, so the New Eve said "Yes" to the message of the Archangel Gabriel and brought Jesus Christ our Savior into the world.

St. Paul put it this way: This saying is trustworthy: if we have died with Him, we shall also live with Him. If we persevere with Him, we shall also reign with Him. (2 Timothy 2:11) Mary was faithful to the Lord all the way to the Cross and beyond. She, in a sense, died with her Son on the Cross. She persevered in living her faith in the Lord in a complete manner throughout her life. Assumed into heaven, Mary now shares the heavenly reign of Jesus Christ.

As we honor Mary this week, I strongly encourage you to participate in one of the three opportunities to go to Mass. The first opportunity is the vigil Mass on Monday, August 14. You can join with hundreds of other Catholics at Mercy Health (Crushers) Stadium, just north of I-90 on Rte. 611 (Stoney Ridge/Colorado Ave.) The Mass will start at 7:00 p.m. However, doors open at 5:30 p.m. and Rosary will be at 6:30 p.m. Since this is one of the area wide Masses celebrating these Years of Eucharistic Revival, there will be a brief time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament after the Mass followed by fireworks. This will be a unique time to honor our Lady and celebrate Christ's Real Presence among us in the Eucharist.

The other two Masses for the Feast of the Assumption will be on Tuesday, August 15 at St. Julie Parish at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. All are welcome at any of these Masses and bring a friend.

Discovering Christ is a seven-week series that helps people, believe it or not, discover Christ! This series is open to anyone and is geared toward helping connect with the person of Jesus Christ. It begins with a free meal. This will be followed by a video on some aspect of Jesus Christ. The evening finishes with some "no pressure" discussion. St. Julie Parish is hosting Discovering Christ beginning Monday, September 11 at 6:00 p.m. with the meal. The program will end at 8:00 p.m.

I encourage you to mark your calendar and sign up for this series. This is a good event to help bring people to faith for the first time or to help others grow in their faith. I hope to see you then.

St. Peter Parish is hosting a Prayer Walk fund raising event this Saturday, August 19 for a second-grader Otto Nowlin. Otto was found to have cancer shortly before Easter this year. Registration begins at 8:30 a.m. and the walk commences at 9:00 AM on the grounds of St. Peter's. There will also be a version of a dunk tank, music and food. In case you are wondering, yes...I will be getting "dunked".

This week's Sunday readings summon us to faith. Whether we sense the voice of the Lord whispering in our hearts or inviting us to get out of the boat and come to him, let us respond to the Lord with faith. He has promised, I will never leave you or forsake you. (Hebrews 13:5b)




