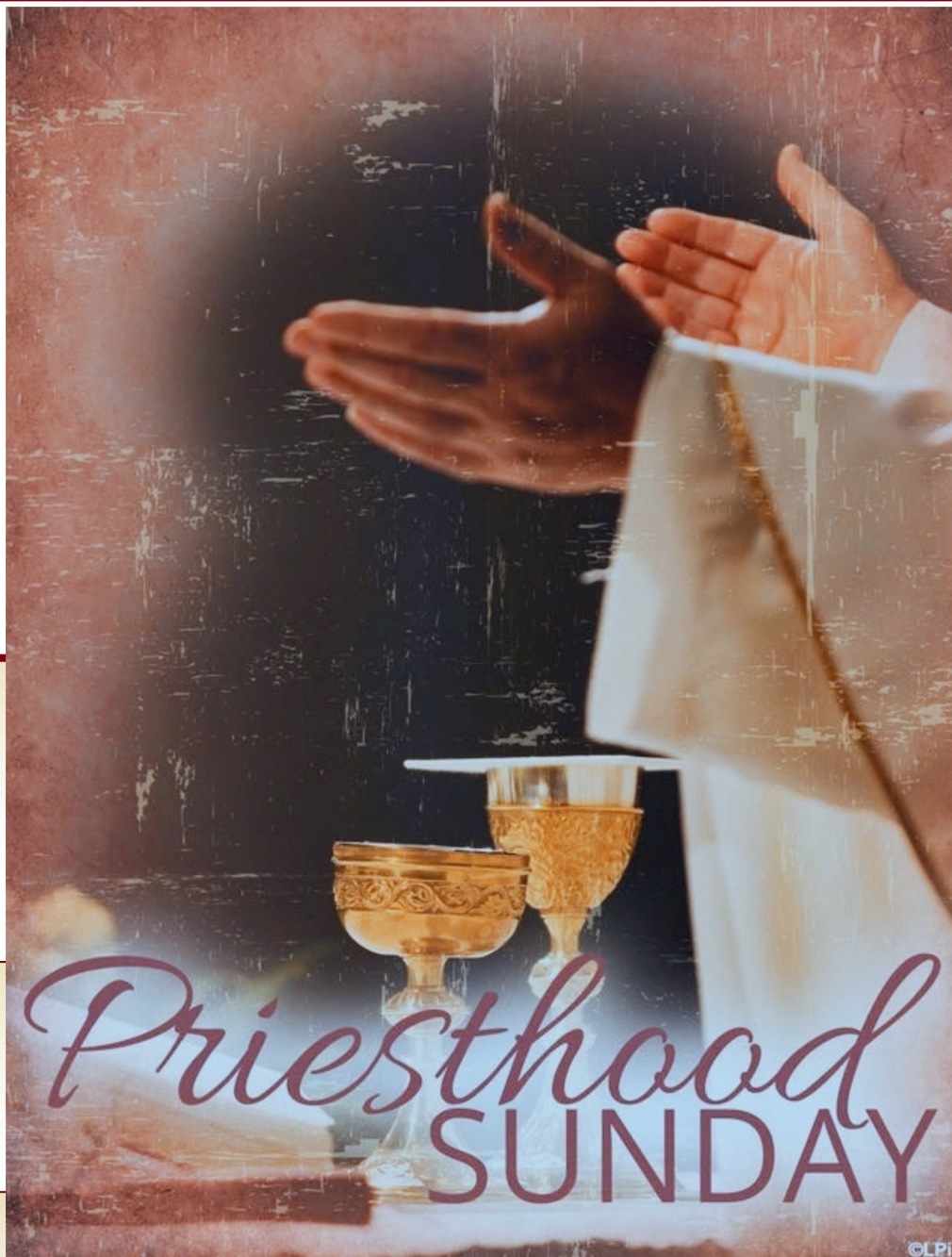

Dear Parishioners,

Though not widely publicized, the year 2026 is a Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi. It is the 800th anniversary of his death. The Year of Jubilee began January 10, 2026 and will conclude January 10, 2027. Pilgrimage sites within our own diocese include St. Anthony Church in Lorain, St. Anthony Church in Parma, Our Lady of the Angels and the Poor Clare Monastery, both on Rocky River Drive in Cleveland. From our Diocesan website: During this time, the faithful have the opportunity to obtain plenary indulgences – a special grace of God's mercy – under the usual conditions: sacramental confession, detachment from sin, Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the pope, by making a pilgrimage to any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world.

The weekend of October 3-4 is a busy weekend for both St. Julie and St. Peter Parishes. There will be a Blessing of Pets at Noon on Saturday, October 3 at St. Julie Parish (at the shrine on Julie Lane) and on Sunday, October 4 at 11:30 AM in the St. Peter Parish playground area. All pets and owners are welcome.

Also on Sunday, October 4 there will be a special training presentation by Catholic Charities hosted at St. Julie Parish called What to do in the Moment. This program will focus on responding to mental health emergencies, teaching crisis intervention training skills and de-escalation techniques. Dr. Edgardo Padin, Lisa Moser and Dr. Dobie Moser will be the presenters. This free presentation will be 1:00-4:00 PM and will begin with a light lunch.

I strongly encourage the ushers, greeters, PSR teachers and security teams to take advantage of this opportunity. This kind of training may prove invaluable.

I participated in my first "Senior Priest" luncheon last Tuesday. Held at the Center for Pastoral Leadership, Bishop Malesic addressed the Senior Priests, seminary faculty and seminarians. He reiterated his main points of his pastoral letter: pray at least 15 minutes a day, know and share your story and be parishes that worship, evangelize and serve the poor. Fr. Bob Sanson, former senior parochial vicar of St. Peter Parish brought Fr. Gonser, the former pastor of St. Julie Parish to the event. Fr. Gonser then hitched a ride home with me, the current pastor of both parishes!

This week I am preaching at all the Masses at St. Peter Parish. Grateful for your generosity, I will give the parish finance report.

This week's readings address people as free moral agents. We are not animals ruled by brute instinct. We are human beings who make choices. Jesus' gospel story describes two sons: one that says "no" to his father, but then does his father's will, and the other son who says "yes" to his father but does not follow through.

Let us always choose to do God's will and be His children in name and in fact.
