

16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioners,

The readings for today's Mass focus on shepherding, both bad and good shepherds. The prophet Jeremiah does not mince words as he calls out self-serving shepherds. King David, by his most famous Psalm 23, describes the Lord as the model shepherd. The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. In the early Church, this psalm was used to highlight Christian initiation: beside restful waters he leads me (Baptism), You spread the table before me (the Eucharist), and You anoint my head with oil (Confirmation). However, more than simply sacramental initiation, a good shepherd warns the flock of impending danger and lays down his life for the flock. In the gospel, when Jesus and the apostles attempted to get to a deserted place, the people figured out their plan and arrived first! Jesus, for his part, did not turn the boat around and go look for another landing place. Instead, Jesus saw these people as sheep without a shepherd. He taught them many things, feeding them with the Word. Then, as we shall see in the coming weeks, with His very Body and Blood.

Pray for the ordained shepherds of the Church in our day. That those who are ordained, remain faithful, and grow in the grace of their ordination. Also ask the Lord of the harvest for more harvesters, for more shepherds, especially ordained priests who will serve with the heart of Jesus.



Ukraine Welcome Circle Updates

It is hard to believe that we are only 6 months into our journey with the Bryiovskyis. We have achieved a lot together.

The boys finished the school term June 21st and went to a church camp for a week. Daniel, Artur and Suisanna are all enjoying all the sports for which you have so generously provided equipment. One of the favorite pastimes for the whole family is swimming. Another donation allowed them to get a family pass to all the public pools in Parma. They take advantage of that as often as they can.

Both Vitalii and Nadiia now have their Ohio Driver licenses! They still have the use a car from Vitalii's brother, but Vitalii took a big step this past month. Using his pay from his job at the logistics company and with some help from his boss, he was able to buy a car from a salvage yard. The car needs a lot of work but, since Vitalii was a mechanic in Ukraine, he will be able to make the repairs himself over the next months.

We are very happy that he took this initiative to plan ahead for when his brother will need his car back. We continue to explore the options to get Vitalii a CDL license to allow him to get a position that not only allows him to use his mechanical skills, but also opens the option of truck driving. This process has been more challenging than anticipated.

We are also exploring ideas with Nadiia to use her sewing skills to help support the family needs.

This past week, we had a couple of challenges at the house because the A/C went out and then there was a backup in the basement from the storm sewer. Our landlord was very responsive to both issues. We made a great team with the family doing a lot of "bailing" until the plumber could get there. The only "casualty" was an area rug in the basement. We are hoping a good cleaning will resolve that.

It is hard to explain how grateful the family is for all the help we have given. We are truly a team giving "A Hand Up and Not a Hand Out."
